




# RECORD FROM WEBCAM AND POST TO YOUTUBE

You can communicate with your students via webcam to make announcements, give feedback, describe assignments, or discuss topics via the discussion board.

You will need a working webcam and microphone for this to work properly. You will also need a YouTube account.

1. Create an announcement and click the **Record from Webcam** button inside the text editor.

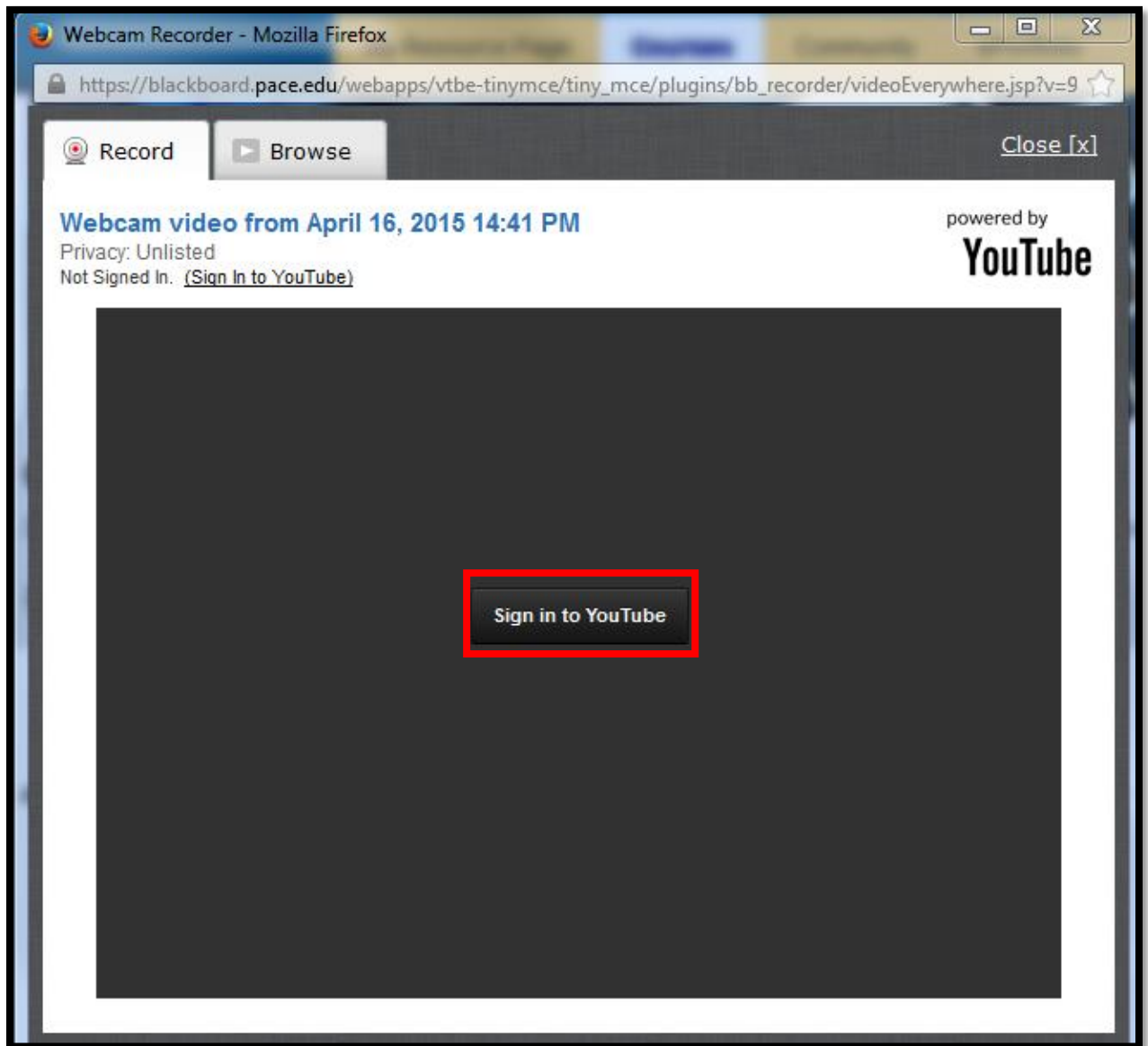

2. Click **Sign in to YouTube**.






3. After entering in your YouTube credentials, you will receive a message that an anonymous application is requesting access to your Google Account. Click **Grant access**.

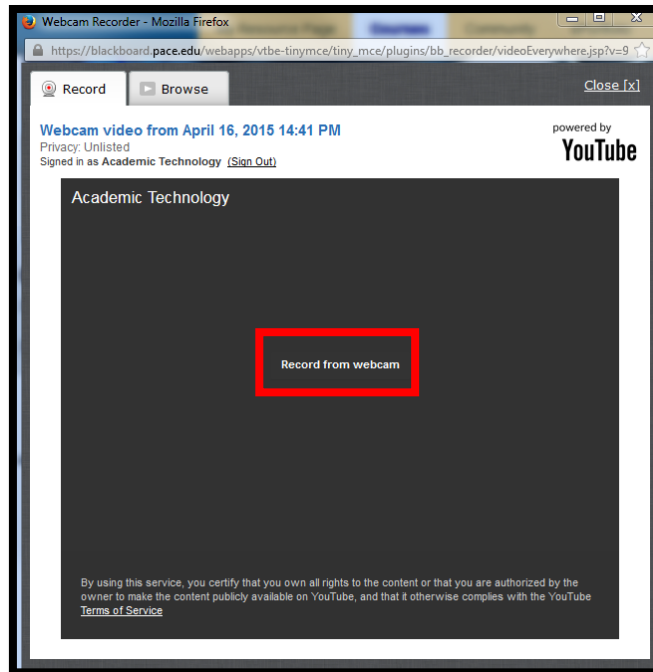

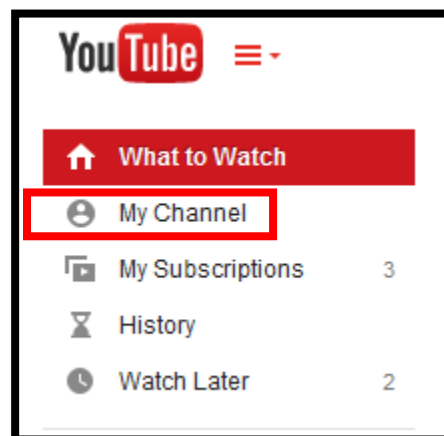

4. Click **Record from webcam**. If you receive a message that reads “unable to retrieve user information” proceed to step 5.



5. If you receive a message that reads “unable to retrieve user information,” you need to create a YouTube channel. Open a new tab and log in to <https://www.youtube.com/>. Sign in and click **My Channel**. You will need to verify your information by clicking **Verify** and inputting a phone number to be called on. YouTube will read you a number to input on the screen. Once this is done, your channel has been created and you can go back in to Blackboard.
