Any research involving human participants that is conducted by a Pace University faculty member, staff member, or students, and meet the federal definition of research, must be reviewed by the IRM. Any individual who wishes to use any of the faculty, staff, or students of Pace University as participants in their research must have his/her research reviewed by the IRM.

According to <u>Federal guidelines</u> (45CFR46, 102(d)), research is defined as: "a systematic investigation, including research development, testing, and evaluation, designed to develop or contribute to generalizable knowledge."
