Understanding Contact Tracing



You've stayed home or in your residence hall room.

Now, answer the phone.

We're all in this together. Tracing exposure to COVID-19 is crucial to maintaining Our Safe Pace.

The New York State (NYS) Contact Tracing program works with individuals who have tested positive for COVID-19 to determine who they have been in contact with. Because the disease can be transmitted without symptoms, notifying people about a possible exposure is critical to stopping the spread of coronavirus.

If you have been identified as a contact, you will get a call from NYS Contact Tracing at (518) 387-9993, or a representative from your own county of residence's department of health.

If you get a call from NYS Contact Tracing, please answer. Note that all calls are confidential and private. Contact tracing is essential to slowing the spread of COVID-19.
