## EXPLANATION OF TERMS

- 1. Acceptable Course Hours: Only undergraduate courses where grades of "C" or better were received are considered acceptable. Only graduate courses where grades of "B" or better were received are considered acceptable. If the previous institution attended was on a quarter hour system, a conversion of hours will be done to reflect the proper number of semester credits for each course. To convert credit hours to the semester system from the quarter system, multiply by 0.667 (example: 4.5 quarter hours x 0.667 = 3 semester hours).
- 2. Pace University Earned Hours: Number of credits for courses completed at the previous institution that have been accepted and applied to your current major. Changing your major will require a re-evaluation of your transfer credits.

Note: Where there is a difference in credits between a course completed at a previous institution and a comparable Pace course, this difference is indicated on the major worksheet as either a credit deficiency or a credit surplus. Deficiencies and surpluses will be made up or applied as an equal number of General/Open Elective, Inquiry Exploration, or Liberal Arts Elective credits.

- 3. <u>Business Core</u>: Credits applied to the Business Core for majors in the Lubin School of Business.
- 4. <u>Inquiry Exploration</u>: Credits evaluated as Inquiry Exploration include any course in the arts and sciences that can be applied to the University Core Curriculum <u>prior</u> to the 2012-13 academic year. Courses in business, computer science, education, health and physical education, and nursing cannot be included in this component of the University Core Curriculum.
- 5. <u>General/Open Elective</u>: Credits evaluated as General/Open electives include any elective course not recorded as Inquiry Exploration or Liberal Arts Elective. No more than two credits of Health and Physical Education are transferable towards a Pace degree.
- 6. <u>Liberal Arts Elective</u> (New Core effective Fall 2012): Credits evaluated as Liberal Arts Elective include any course in the arts and sciences that can be applied to the University Core Curriculum <u>effective the 2012-13</u> academic year.
- 7. Pace Equivalent Comments: These transfer credits cannot be applied to your major or require further action. Please review comment definitions
- elow:

  (a) <u>Sent to Dept for Eval</u>: Course description from the school/college's catalog has been sent to the appropriate chairperson for departmental
- (b) <u>Submit Syllabus</u>: Submit the course syllabus for departmental review.
- (c) Excess: Acceptable credits that cannot be applied towards your current degree program.
- (d) No Credit Granted: Department chairperson has determined the course is not transferable towards a Pace degree program.

NOTE: A maximum of 68 credits may be transferred from accredited two-year institutions toward a baccalaureate degree program. A maximum of 96 credits may be transferred to a baccalaureate degree program from accredited four-year institutions.

The number of transferable credits is limited by the degree program to which the credits will be applied. All students are required to complete a minimum of 32 credits and 50% of their major and 50% of their minor requirements at Pace University. A major program is defined as those courses directly related to the student's primary course of study (e.g., accounting, marketing, history, mathematics, computer science, etc.).
