Satisfactory Academic Progress Review

What is Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and how does it impact your financial aid?

The Federal Government requires students maintain a specific level of academic progress (QPA and completion rate) to retain financial aid.

We review SAP at the end of **each** Spring semester.

If you are not making SAP you are at risk of losing your Federal and Institutional aid (i.e. Merit Scholarships, Pace Grant, Stafford loans, etc.) effective Summer 2022.
