As they look at their chosen book they sometimes come to know more about it than I do.


16 students x 16 publications = many new constellations

These are works made in spaces of unmastery and I try to make an unmastered classroom.



This fact can be intentional or circumstantial. Either way, this fact is a sign telling us that we are on the outside, we are in the underneath of publication.








