Student Academic Progress

The Federal Government requires students maintain a specific level of academic progress (QPA and completion rate) to retain financial aid eligibility.

Academic Progress is reviewed at the end of each Spring semester. If you are not making Satisfactory Academic Progress after the Spring 2023 semester you are at risk of losing your Federal, State & Institutional financial aid.

If you are at risk of not making Satisfactory Academic Progress after Spring 2023, you may want to consider enrolling in Summer courses at Pace.

Only courses taken at Pace University will impact your QPA.
