At-Risk Student Criteria

How do we define an at-risk student?

- Failure of 2 or more exams in 1 course (didactic)
- Failure of 3 or more exams in 1 semester (didactic)
- Failure of Mid Term Human Physiology course (didactic)
- Lower 5% in Clinical Medicine course (didactic)
- Failure of Comprehensive Clin med exam (clinical)
- Failure of 2 or more EOR exams (clinical)

At-Risk Process

- Identified at-risk students are placed in a guided study program and offered tutoring.
- The remediation process for at-risk students starts at the beginning of the clinical year.
- Identified at-risk students who failed to demonstrate the requisite knowledge on interval assessments will be referred to the Director of Remediation at the beginning of clinical year.
- The Director of Remediation will work with these students providing program guidance throughout the remediation process.
