DATES OF OCCUPANCY

Permission to occupy will commence on the Date of Arrival specified on the first page of this agreement. Resident shall take occupancy not later than three days after this Date of Arrival. Failure to take occupancy by the aforesaid Date of Arrival or to notify the Office of Housing and Residential Life in writing of late arrival may result in cancellation of this agreement. The room assigned pursuant to this agreement shall be vacated by the Date of Departure listed on the front of this agreement or after notice of termination.

CHECK-IN/OUT

A staff member prior to check in will inspect each room. Resident will be responsible for any damages that occur during the period of occupancy, including but not limited to the loss of keys & identification card. Resident will be issued a front door and a room key. There is a missing key/card charge of \$75.00, which will be billed to Resident.

OCCUPANCY BY RESIDENT ONLY

Only the Resident shall occupy the assigned room. Residents may not sublet or assign the space for occupancy by other individuals.

UNIVERSITY RIGHT TO ENTER RESIDENTS ROOMS

The University reserves the unconditional right to enter the room occupied by the Resident pursuant to this agreement in the interest of health, safety, and conduct of it's residence hall program. Residence Life Staff and other authorized University personnel may enter the students room at any time for cleaning, inventory, maintenance, inspection, repairs or upon reasonable grounds in the belief that a crime or violation of the University's rules and regulations has been or is being committed. Authorized University personnel may enter a room for any of these purposes whether or not the occupants are present and may confiscate any unauthorized or illegal items that they may find in the room.

LIABILITY FOR DAMAGE - INDEMNIFICATION

The Resident shall be responsible for any and all damages to the room occupied by the Resident. Resident is further responsible for sharing the cost of damages in and to the public areas as determined by the University. The Resident will not drive or permit to be driven, nails, hooks, tacks or screws into any part of the room and will not make or allow to be made any alterations of any kind.

Resident agrees to indemnify and hold Pace University, its officers, employees and agents harmless from and against all liability for damages, fines, claims, causes of action and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising from the negligent or willfully wrongful acts or omissions of Resident and guests of the Resident while at the University's premises in connection with this agreement, including but not limited to claims of personal injury and property damage.

PROPERTY LOSS OR DAMAGE

The University assumes no responsibility of any kind for loss or damage to personal property caused by fire, water, theft or any other cause whatsoever. Personal property stored in University facilities during the period of this agreement shall be stored at the owner's own risk.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND UNIVERSITY REGULATIONS

Resident agrees to comply with all laws, codes, ordinances and rules of Pace University and local, state and federal governments, applicable to the use of the University's facilities. The laws of the State of New York shall govern this agreement. All litigation arising from this agreement will be conducted in a court of appropriate jurisdiction Westchester County, of New York.

The Resident will be held responsible for official notices of procedures or policies communicated by Residence Life Offices via its staff or through University mailing systems.

SMOKING PROHIBITED

In accordance with applicable Fire Codes and Ordinances, there will be no smoking on the University's premises.

TERMINATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

The University reserves the right to terminate this agreement in the event the Resident fails to meet the financial obligation to the University or abide by applicable laws, the rules and regulations of the University and/or the terms of this agreement; to reassign or repossess the room and to effect any other steps necessary, or advisable in the sole discretion of the Director of Residential Life or the Dean for Students, acting in the interest of health, safety and conduct of this residence hall program. In such event, the Resident may be required to vacate the residence hall immediately and may be notified that he/she will be treated as a trespasser if he/she returns without approval.
