Dear Pace Student,

It's only the beginning of summer, but we're already looking forward to welcoming you back for the fall semester at Pace. To ensure that you're prepared when it's time to head back to class, please read the following information outlining billing deadlines and important changes to our nonpayment process.

**Your fall bill payment will be due August 1, 2023.** This means you must finalize financial arrangements to satisfy your bill before this date. **Students who have not arranged payment by August 1, 2023, will be charged a late fee, and anyone with an account not in good standing will be dropped from Fall 2023 Semester classes for nonpayment as of August 8, 2023.**


To be ready to meet this important deadline:

- Submit your [FAFSA](#) if you have not already done so.
- Review your Cost of Attendance and Financial Aid package, now available on your student portal.
- Provide any verification paperwork requested from Financial Aid
- Access your fall bill on the [Student Payment Portal](#) as soon as it's available, starting on June 20, 2023.
- Review payment arrangement options on [Pace's payment information webpage](#).

If you are dropped for nonpayment, your class schedule will not be held. This policy is a change from prior semesters. Those students who are dropped for nonpayment will be able to reregister once they have made financial arrangements to satisfy their semester bill. Reregistration will be permitted through September 19, 2023, the last day to add classes for the Fall 2023 Semester, subject to current course availability.
