### **DRIVER LICENSE PENALTIES**

In general, the penalties described below are for convictions for violations committed while driving vehicles that do not require a commercial driver license

## **Driving While Intoxicated**

(.08 and higher blood alcohol content or other evidence of intoxication)

First Offense (misdemeanor)Minimum \$500; Maximum \$1,000Up to one year Minimum six-month revocation

Second Offense within 10 years, Class E felony Minimum \$1,000; Maximum \$5,000 Up to 4 years Minimum one-year revocation\*

3rd Offense within 10 years Class D felonyMinimum \$2,000; Maximum \$10,000Up to seven years Minimum one year revocation\*

### **Driving with Ability Impaired**

(more than .05 and up to .07 blood alcohol content)

Fine ImprisonmentLicense

First Offense (traffic infraction Minimum \$300; Maximum \$500 Up to 15 days 90-day suspension

Second Offense within five years (traffic infraction)Minimum \$500; Maximum \$750 Up to 30 daysMinimum six month revocation\*

Third Offense within 10 years (misdemeanor) Minimum \$750; Maximum \$1,500 Up to 180 days Minimum six-month revocation\* (if current violation occurred within five years of previous violation)

# Drivers Under 21 Years of Age

(blood alcohol content .02 to .07)

Civil Penalty License Additional Fee

First Offense Minimum \$125 Six-month suspension \$100 suspension

termination fee

Second Offense Minimum \$125 One year revocation or until age 21, whichever is longer \$100 reapplication fee
