The New Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is Coming!

Encourage your student to check their email for updates and the launch date.

Currently, the 2024-2025 FAFSA is expected to be available in **December 2023**. In the meantime, it is important that all contributors to the FAFSA are ready and have created their own Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID

Once the 2024-2025 FAFSA becomes available, complete yours as soon as possible to maximize your aid eligibility. **Be careful not to refile the current 2023-2024 FAFSA in error!**

The Student Loan payment pause has ended, and interest rates have returned to their current fixed rate. It is important to identify your loan servicer and make sure they have your current contact information. If you are unsure who your loan servicer is, log into the Federal Student Aid website.
