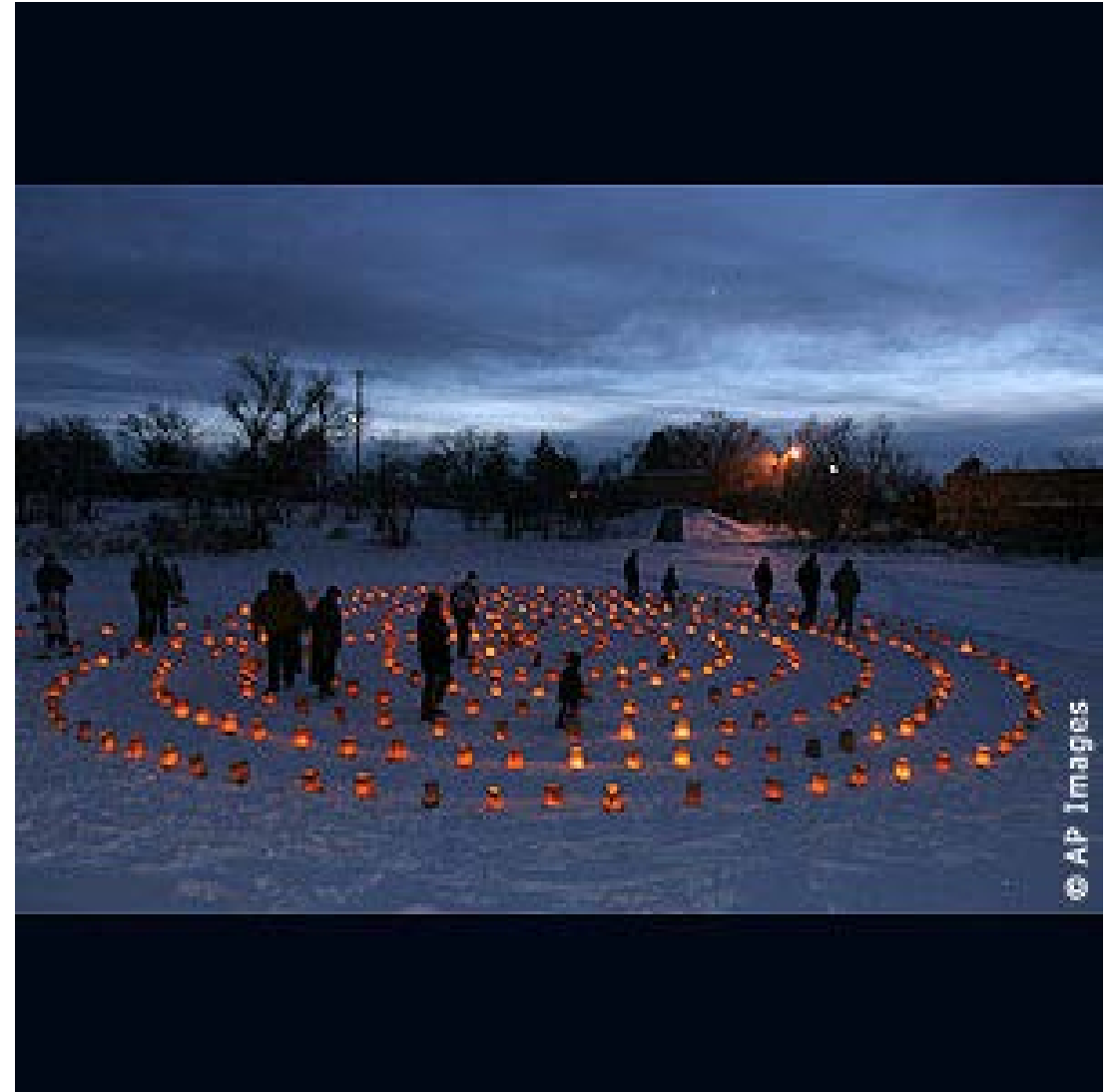
Summer Programs
