All candidates must file an <u>Application for Graduation and Diploma</u>. On the application you wil provide information including:

- Verification of how your legal name should be displayed on your diploma and in the May 2024 Commencement program
- Graduation date
- Degree program information
- Diploma mailing address

May 2024 graduation candidates must apply by March 13, 2024.

August 2024 graduation candidates must apply by **July 20, 2024** (March 13, 2024, if you plan to participate in the May 2024 Commencement ceremony).

Submit your application as soon as possible and remember that you can check the status from your Pace Portal account. Access your student profile and select the term from the top left corner of the screen. You will find "Graduation Information" under your academic information. Click on the "Active" link to view the status of your graduation application.

If your graduation status does not state pending, is blank or inactive, or you need other assistance, please <u>submit a Helpdesk inquiry to the Office of the Registrar</u>. All questions about your degree eligibility and course credits must be directed to your **Academic Advisor**. <u>Visit</u> <u>your college or school advising website</u>.

Additionally, if the name you would like on your diploma does not match your legal name as it appears on your Pace records, <u>contact the Office of the Registrar</u> and complete the <u>General</u> <u>Change form</u>, which can be found on the <u>Registrar Forms webpage</u>.

Please note: The Application for Graduation does **NOT** secure your participation in the May 2024 <u>Commencement</u> ceremony. All information about the Commencement Ceremony, including how to register and request tickets, will be provided separately via your Pace email.
