TRANSFER TO PACE TODAY.

- Pace's flexible transfer credit policy allows you to transfer credit for courses completed with a grade of C or better, taken at regionally accredited institutions. Pace accepts a maximum of 96 credits from a four-year institution and 68 from a two-year institution.
- You may be eligible for a merit award up to \$16,000 per year. Our robust financial aid packages are designed to make a private education affordable. An additional award of \$1,000 per year is available for members of Phi Theta Kappa and Alpha Beta Gamma.
- More than 100 majors and accelerated bachelor's and graduate degree programs to choose from, with small class sizes.
- Pace has one of the largest internship programs of any university in the New York metropolitan area.

ATTEND A TRANSFER ACCELERATED ADMISSION DAY

Pace offers special Accelerated Admission Days for transfer applicants. Submit your application online and bring all official college transcripts in order to:

- Receive a \$50 application fee waiver
- Meet with your admission counselor and receive an on-the-spot admission decision*
- See how your previously earned credits will transfer to your Pace degree
- Eligible students typically earned a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Students who fall below this GPA will still be considered for admission and can discuss their academic performance with their admission counselor.
