The **2025-2026** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is Coming December 1st!

- If you and your student don't already have a valid, active FSA ID please be sure to create one at StudentAid.gov.
- If this is your student's first time filing the FAFSA be sure you have your social security number handy and use your legal name (what is listed on your social security card) on your FAFSA.
- For our NYS residents, the [NYS TAP application](#) will be available in December to be in line with the FAFSA application.
