Born and raised in New York, Brian began his dance training at age 13 under Francis Patrelle while attending LaGuardia High School for the Performing Arts and the School of American Ballet. By his senior year, he was one of only 20 dancers nationwide to win The YoungArts Competition and among just 24 dancers worldwide accepted into the prestigious Juilliard School.

Upon graduating, Brian went straight to Broadway, where he thrived for 15 years. He originated the role of Baby Boy in Urban Cowboy, played James in Twyla Tharp's Movin' Out, and brought to life Neleus in Mary Poppins. His career has taken him to some of the most renowned venues in the country, including The New York State Theatre, Alice Tully Hall, and Avery Fisher Hall. A true crossover artist, he has performed works by Killian, Van Manen, Duato, and Forsythe, and has had the privilege of guesting with the acclaimed Nederlands Dans Theater and various ballet companies nationwide.

Beyond the stage, Brian has made his mark on screen. He appears in the hit feature film Across the Universe, HBO's The Other Two, and The New York Philharmonic's Live from Lincoln Center tribute to Marvin Hamlisch.

Now, as a professor of classical ballet and theatre dance at PACE University in NYC, Brian brings over two decades of experience to the next generation of artists. His teaching philosophy blends technical precision with the artistry required to captivate audiences—helping students develop the skills, versatility, and confidence to command the stage.

Lauren Gaul (La Grange)

Lauren Gaul is the Associate Director of Sands College of Performing Arts and Interim Program Head of the BFA Commercial Dance Program. She co-founded/co-created the BFA Commercial Dance program and received her MFA from the Conservatory of Dance, Purchase College SUNY. Lauren performed as a Radio City Rockette for 10 years and also served as a Rockette Swing. Shelby Kaufman (Romeo + Juliet)

From Lincoln Center and Jacob's Pillow to the Today Show and Sesame Street, Shelby Kaufman has made her mark on top stages and screens. She choreographed 4X Tony nominated Tovah Feldshuh's 'Aging is Optional,' assistant choreographed Off-Broadway shows 'Nobody Loves You,' with Mandy Moore and 'Freckleface, The Musical' with Gail Crutchfield, and was protégé to tap legend Dr. Harold 'Stumpy' Cromer. She has danced in Brenda Bufalino and Germaine Salsberg's tap companies, and currently teaches at Broadway Dance Center, Steps on Broadway, ShufflesNYC, and tap workshops worldwide. Her social media has garnered over 70 million views.

Nijawwon K. Matthews (Dangerous Minds)

Nijawwon K. Matthews (he/they) is an Internationally acclaimed choreographer, master teacher, and performer. In 2024 he was awarded a New York Dance Festival Choreographic Fellowship at the School of American Ballet and premiered his work "From Dystopia To Our Declaration" at the Joyce Theater, performed by Philidanco. Nijawwon taught at Joffrey School of Ballet in NYC for over a decade and presently teaches at Broadway Dance Center. He continues to instruct and create for professional companies, colleges, and studios around the world.
