ACCESSING YOUR STAGE PASS AND GUEST TICKETS

<u>Log in to Tassel</u> to access your Stage Pass and guest tickets.

WHEN TO ARRIVE

Graduates should plan to arrive at least one hour before their scheduled ceremony start time. Graduates and guests with accessibility needs should plan to arrive 1.5–2 hours prior to their ceremony start time.

Your Stage Pass and guest tickets include the timing of your ceremonies. You can also <u>view</u> the schedule of events on the Commencement website.

HOW TO GET IN

On arrival, all graduates and guests will enter through the East Gate Main Entrance. Print or screenshot your Stage Pass and guest tickets in advance to avoid entry delays.

Graduates must present their Stage Passes at Graduate Check-in in the East Plaza, after entering at the East Gate Main Entrance.

Guests must present their tickets at the East Gate Main Entrance. After entering the venue, guests should proceed to Louis Armstrong Stadium for their graduate's ceremony.

Anyone without a Stage Pass or guest ticket will be prohibited from entering the venue.
