Josh's two decades of leadership experience include growing consumer technology companies and scaling global marketplaces. He previously served as President of Consumer Products and Services at American Express, CEO of Skype, and CEO of shopping.com. He also held various executive roles at eBay. Earlier in his career, Josh co-founded Evite, Inc. where he also served as the company's CEO. He is currently on the board of directors of Shake Shack.

Josh was previously a member of the Stanford Business School Management board and the Lincoln Center Theater board.

Launette Woolforde, EdD '93

Launette Woolforde, EdD '93 is the Deputy Chief Nursing Officer for Northwell Health and an assistant professor at the Donald & Barbara Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell.

With 88,000 employees including 19,000 nurses, Northwell Health is the largest employer and largest health system in New York State. Dr. Woolforde developed its system-wide nurse residency program, which is accredited with distinction from the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC). She established the health systems infrastructure that enabled growth from three Magnet hospitals to 11 presently—the most of any health system in New York.

Dr. Woolforde began her 32-year nursing career as a student at Pace University, earning a Bachelor of Science in Nursing from the Leinhard School of Nursing. She earned a master's from Hunter College and a Post-Master's Certificate from The College of New Rochelle. She earned a Doctor of Nursing Practice from Case Western Reserve University as well as a Doctor of Education from Columbia University, Teachers College, pursuing both degrees simultaneously and becoming the first nurse at Northwell to earn two doctoral degrees.

Dr. Woolforde has been an Executive Board Member at the National League for Nursing—the country's oldest nursing organization—and served on the Board of the Association for Nursing Professional Development (ANPD). For her many contributions to the profession of nursing, Dr. Woolforde received the Sigma Theta Tau Honor Society for Nursing International Founders Award, was named the American Nurses Credentialing Center's National Certified Nurse of the Year, and was inducted into the Columbia University, Teachers College Alumni Hall of Fame. She holds two board certifications and is a Fellow of the New York Academy of Medicine, the Health Management Academy and the esteemed American Academy of Nursing.

For her exceptional leadership in nursing education, her transformative contributions to healthcare delivery, and her passionate advocacy for future generations of healthcare professionals, Pace University is honored to confer Dr. Launette Woolforde the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Anjali Sud

Anjali Sud is CEO of Tubi, America's most watched free TV and movie streaming service. Under Sud's leadership, the company has exhibited exciting growth and momentum, scaling to over 97 million monthly active viewers, expanding globally, and solidifying its position as a major entertainment destination.

Prior to Tubi, Anjali served as CEO of Vimeo, the global online video platform. During her six-year tenure, she took the company public and established Vimeo as the home for video creators and professionals worldwide, building a community of over 300 million users. Before that, she held various positions in e-commerce and media at Amazon and Time Warner.

Anjali has been featured in *Fortune's* 40 under 40, The Hollywood Reporter's Most Powerful Women in Entertainment, Bloomberg's Ones to Watch, and CNBC's Changemakers. She is a designated Young Global Leader of the World Economic Forum and a Henry Crown Fellow at the Aspen Institute. She serves on the board of directors of Dolby Laboratories, SiriusXM, and as Chair of the board of Change.org. Anjali grew up in Flint, Michigan, and lives in New York City with her husband and two young sons.

Robert S. Tucker '96

Robert S. Tucker '96 is the 35th New York City Fire Commissioner. A lifelong New Yorker, Commissioner Tucker grew up in Manhattan and attended George Washington University. He went to law school at the Pace University at night while working as the special assistant to the late Queens District Attorney Richard A. Brown. The experience allowed him to work closely with an extensive network of executive-level members of the New York City Police Department and the City administration, as well as the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the US Secret Service, and other public safety entities.

In 1999, he founded T&M USA, an international security and investigations firm. During his time at T&M, he was also devoted to philanthropic work. This included service as a trustee to the New York City Police Foundation as well as membership of the Board of Directors at White Plains Hospital, Pace University, and the FDNY Foundation.

As a 1996 graduate of the Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University, Commissioner Tucker has a deep connection to his alma mater and served on Pace University's Board of Trustees from 2018 until 2024. In 2017, through his generous support, Haub Law established the Robert S. Tucker Prize for Prosecutorial Excellence to recognize individuals who have made outstanding contributions to criminal prosecution and exemplify excellence in prosecutorial practice.

Commissioner Tucker prides himself on being a son of the city and the father of three children—two daughters and a son. He is also the grandson of the late Richard Tucker, an American operatic tenor and cantor long associated with the Metropolitan Opera.

Serving as the FDNY Commissioner is the realization of Commissioner Tucker's lifelong dream.

Today, for his distinguished leadership in public service, for his dedication to pursuing justice with integrity, and for his enduring commitment to the legal profession and his alma mater, the Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University is proud to confer upon Robert S. Tucker the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Opportunitas in Action Award

The *Opportunitas in Action Award*, bestowed by the president of Pace University, recognizes a leader who has made innovative, positive contributions to the community in the spirit of Pace's motto, *Opportunitas*.

Lorelei Atalie Vargas

Lorelei Atalie Vargas has three decades of experience in the non-profit and government sectors creating community-level opportunities that strengthen the lives of children and families. Lorelei currently serves as Chief Community Impact Officer of Trinity Church, where she developed and led a place-based initiative to address the wellbeing of communities in lower Manhattan by combining targeted philanthropic investments with on-the-ground support to address immediate needs and root causes. She also sits on several boards, most recently joining the board of the Puerto Rican Women's Foundation, the first and only women's fund in Puerto Rico that exists to support organizations that serve and advocate for women, girls, and the non-binary community.

Prior to her current appointments, Lorelei served as Deputy Commissioner for Child and Family Well-Being with the City of New York's Administration for Children's Services. There she advocated for, designed, developed, and administered the country's first child welfare division dedicated to using a two-generation approach to strengthen programs, leverage existing resources, and build on the assets that are inherent in families. In addition, she has previously served as New York City's deputy commissioner of early care and education, leading the country's largest publicly funded subsidized childcare system, serving the needs of close to 110,000 children with a budget of over \$1 billion annually. In this role, Lorelei successfully led reforms that expanded access to and improved the quality of care for low-income children. Before entering city government, Lorelei spent over a decade at a Westchester-based nonprofit where she led the organization's work to implement a trauma informed organizational culture model in over 300 child-serving organizations world-wide. Lorelei's career has allowed her to spend time both in New York City government and nonprofit settings in New York, Detroit, Chicago and Philadelphia, providing her a rich understanding of the systems that exist to support low-income and oppressed communities. She uses that knowledge to shape sustainable change for families, communities, policies, and systems.

Fully bilingual in English and Spanish, Lorelei earned her Bachelor of Arts degree from Bryn Mawr College, where she currently serves as a member of the Board of Trustees, and as a member of the Board of Advisors for Bryn Mawr's Graduate School of Social Work and Research. Lorelei also holds two master's degrees—one in public policy and one in education administration and policy—from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, where she was a Woodrow Wilson Fellow. Lorelei was named a Pahara Fellow (2017) for her work on equity in early childhood education and an Ascend Fellow (2018) for her leadership in developing two-generation systems from the Aspen Institute where she is a member of the Aspen Global Network. In 2020, Lorelei was named to New York's City and State's Responsible100 list for her thought leadership in creating transformational social change during the pandemic, and in 2024 was the recipient of the Partnership for Afterschool Education's Afterschool Champion award for her career-long commitment to supporting opportunities to advance the education of youth.

Due to her unwavering dedication to improving lives, her innovative two-generation strategies, and her commitment to addressing systemic inequities, Lorelei Vargas exemplifies the essence of *Opportunitas*. We are very pleased to present her with Pace University's 2025 *Opportunitas in Action Award*.

Vishal Lala, PhD

*Professor, Marketing
Lubin School of Business*

Professor Vishal Lala is a professor of marketing in the Lubin School of Business, Pace University. He is passionate about working at the intersection of marketing, statistics, and computer science.

His research interests include consumer decision making, electronic media, and promotion. His publications have appeared in marketing and e-commerce journals such as *Journal of Advertising Research*, *Journal of Business Research*, *Journal of Interactive Marketing*, and *Psychology & Marketing*. He teaches quantitative courses in marketing such as marketing research, predictive analytics, and visual analytics.

Jennifer Pankowski, EdD

*Associate Professor
School of Education*

Professor Jennifer Pankowski's background is as a childhood and childhood special education teacher both in Long Island and NYC. At her core, Professor Pankowski considers herself a practitioner who leverages her expertise in pedagogy and research to best support the development and preparation of new teachers working with the next generation of diverse learners.

Her current research focuses include using Artificial Intelligence to minimize implicit bias in teacher instruction and parent communications, as well as the use of simulation and rehearsal to better support novice and pre-service teachers. She currently mentors three undergraduate students from the Seidenberg School of Computer Science and Information Systems to support the use of computer science and the metaverse in teacher preparation resources. Professor Pankowski is currently working with multiple colleges nationally and internationally to improve the use of mixed-reality simulations for teacher preparation using AI.

Professor Pankowski is the Director of Alternative Certification Programs in Pace's School of Education. Additionally, she is the Senior Faculty Fellow for the Pace University Faculty Center.

After completing her educational doctoral degree at Long Island University in curriculum and instruction in 2013, she joined Pace where she is responsible for overseeing the special education programs as well as the proper functioning and quality of the alternative certification programs in the School of Education. She is currently the sub-committee chair for school-age children on the NYS Commissioner's Advisory Panel for Special Education and is on the editorial board for *Journal of Behavioural Science*, an international peer review journal.

Pleasantville Kenan Award for Teaching Excellence

Sharon Wexler, PhD

*Professor, Nursing
College of Health Professions*

Professor Sharon Wexler is the Amelia A. Gould Endowed Professor for PhD Nursing and Chairperson of the PhD in Nursing in the Lienhard School of Nursing within Pace's College of Health Professions. She teaches statistical methods and dissertation development and proposal seminars in the PhD Department and is chairperson of many student dissertations.

Professor Wexler's program of research focuses on improving functional and cognitive status of older adults, specifically gerotechnology: the use of technology to improve outcomes in older adults across the continuum of care.

Professor Wexler is a Board Certified Gerontological Clinical Nurse Specialist. She is a Fellow of the National Gerontological Nurses Association and the New York Academy of Medicine, and also holds an appointment as a part-time nurse scientist at Jamaica Hospital Medical Center.

Professor Wexler came to Pace in the Fall of 2009 and was the Program Director of the Accelerated BS in Nursing from 2010–2020 before transitioning to the PhD in Nursing.

She earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Simmons University, her master's in nursing education and PhD in Nursing Research and Theory Development from New York University's Rory Meyers College of Nursing.

Distinguished Professor

Lauren Birney, EdD

*Professor of STEM Education
School of Education*

Professor Lauren B. Birney is an urban STEM educator with 40 years of experience encompassing both high school and university tenures. Professor Birney works collaboratively with partners and affiliates in creating STEM content, defining curriculum and assessment systems, and conducting program evaluation services for the K-12 STEM community. She is Director of the STEM Collaboratory NYC® program—a leader in enabling students, teachers, faculty, and scientists to engage in the fields of STEM education, create meaningful science curricula, and provide interactive inquiry-based professional development for teachers.

Professor Birney was awarded \$5.4 million from the National Science Foundation. Her research is focused on STEM education and environmental science with 44 partners throughout the United States. She has received \$10.4 million in funding from the National Science Foundation and a career total of \$20 million to support her collaborative work. She has published more than 40 papers, 84 global presentations, and continues her transcontinental work to increase and leverage partnerships to establish Pace University as a leader in STEM education. She is honored to work alongside our stakeholders and alliances to raise visibility for university partnerships.

Professor Birney earned a bachelor's degree in biology/chemistry from the University of San Diego, as well as a master's in counseling and an EdD in Educational Leadership from the USC Rossier School of Education.

Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award

The Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award is presented to the full-time faculty member who has demonstrated exemplary dedication to teaching, service, scholarship, a long-standing commitment to excellence in their discipline, and has made an indelible impact on Pace University.

Nicholas Robinson, JD

*Professor of Environmental Law
Elisabeth Haub School of Law*

Professor Nicholas A. Robinson is widely recognized in the United States and globally as a pioneer of modern environmental law. He began developing environmental law in 1969 when he was named to the Legal Advisory Committee of the President's Council on Environmental Quality.

Professor Robinson has been a distinguished member of the faculty at the Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University since 1978. In 2009, Pace University conferred the prestigious position of University Professor for the Environment on Professor Robinson for his significant contribution to scholarship in the field of environmental law in the United States and abroad. He also holds the title of inaugural Gilbert and Sarah Kerlin Distinguished Professor of Environmental Law Emeritus and was Chair Emeritus of the International Union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN) World Commission on Environment Law, serving from 1996 to 2004.

During his tenure at the Elisabeth Haub School of Law School, Professor Robinson helped establish its environmental law programs, founded the environmental law review, launched the Pace Environmental Law Clinic, secured Pace's membership in the IUCN, and pioneered the first United Nation's Environmental Diplomacy Practicum. His work and influence can be attributed to advancing Haub Law's premier reputation as the top-ranked environmental law program in the nation and across the globe.

Professor Robinson is a prolific legal scholar with hundreds of books, chapters, law review and scholarly journal articles, and citations to his credit on pressing topics. In addition, a collection of his work is preserved in the Nicholas A. Robinson Seminar Space at Haub Law School. Demonstrating his impact in the field of environmental law, Professor Robinson has been honored with numerous awards and accolades. Two awards have also been established in his honor to celebrate outstanding achievement in the field of environmental law: the Nicholas Robinson Award for Distinguished Environmental Achievement—established at Haub Law in 2005—and the Nicholas Robinson Award for Excellence in Environmental Law, created by the IUCN World Commission on Environmental Law in 2021.

Barbara C. Salken Outstanding Professor of the Year Award

The Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University Barbara C. Salken Outstanding Professor of the Year Award honors a full-time and adjunct professor(s) who displays incredible commitment and character to their students. Recipients are selected annually by a vote of the graduating class.

Leslie Y. Garfield Tenzer

Professor of Law

Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University

Professor Tenzer joined the faculty of Haub Law in 1990 and teaches Commercial Law, Contracts, Torts, and Social Media Law. She is the Semi-Centennial Faculty Scholar and previously served as the James D. Hopkins Professor of Law Chair from 2019–2021. Her scholarship and teaching bridge the worlds of theory and practice, with a particular focus on regulating conduct in the digital age. Prior to coming to Haub Law, Professor Tenzer was a legislative attorney in the legal division of the Council of the City of New York.

Professor Tenzer is a dynamic teacher and committed scholar who brings forward thinking approaches to legal education. She is deeply committed to fostering a culture of justice, equity, diversity, and inclusion. She has led impactful initiatives in this area, helping to create an all-embracing campus environment in divisive times. A dedicated mentor, Professor Tenzer empowers students as they navigate their career paths, offering both guidance and inspiration. She is the faculty advisor to the *Pace Law Review* and host of two popular podcasts for students, *Law to Fact*, and *Legal Tenzer: Casual Conversations on Noteworthy Legal Topics*.

Professor Tenzer is the recipient of numerous awards, including the Goettel Prize for Faculty Scholarship in 2020 and 2012, the Faculty Award for Excellence in Teaching in 2024, the Ottinger Prize for Faculty Achievement in 2013 and 2004, and the Outstanding Professor of the Year Award in 2014.

Robin Frankel

Adjunct Professor of Law

Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University

Professor Frankel is a supervising attorney in the Barbara C. Salken Criminal Justice Clinic at Haub Law. She joined Haub Law as an Adjunct Professor of Law in 2012 and is a two-time recipient of the Outstanding Professor of the Year Award. A career public defender, she began practicing in 1987 in the Legal Aid Society Criminal Defense Division's Manhattan office and currently practices at its South Bronx office. She has tried more than 60 cases to verdict.

Professor Frankel serves as a mentor for junior attorneys, externs, and interns. She has created a training on the handling of a felony designed for junior attorneys. Additionally, Professor Frankel has supervised Family Services of Westchester's Juvenile Law Program, where she trained Haub Law students to conduct "Know Your Rights" and criminal law workshops for middle-school students. Professor Frankel is a frequent moot court and mock trial judge, as well as a NITA program participant at Columbia, Hofstra, CUNY, and New York Law School. Recently, Professor Frankel was responsible for dismissals on two wrongful arrest cases after she successfully convinced the prosecutor that their cases were based on misidentification of clothes. These—cases if not dismissed—could have led to decades of needless prison sentences for both innocent men.

2025 Trustee Award

The Trustee Award is presented to the graduating student or students whose positive contributions to University life and whose academic accomplishments exemplify the highest level of achievement attainable for an undergraduate.

New York City

During her time at Pace, **Layne Davis** has distinguished herself as a gifted student with a strong commitment to advocacy and a steadfast dedication to justice.

In the classroom, Layne has demonstrated she is among Pace's brightest students. She's maintained an impressive 3.97 GPA while balancing two majors: political science and peace and justice studies. Her senior capstone entitled, "Best of Both Worlds? Understanding Black-White Biracial Identity Formation in Pace University Students Navigating a Predominantly White Institution" has been recognized at several conferences, including the highly competitive Student Peace Conference at the Kroc Institute for International Peace Studies held at the University of Notre Dame; a conference that attracts master's and doctoral-level applicants from all over the world.

Layne has built an impressive set of accomplishments in the international peacebuilding and justice space. She was recognized as a United Nations (UN) Millenium Fellow through which she facilitated collaborative discussions with Pace's Title IX Coordinator and held events to promote dialogue about Title IX amongst Pace students. In Fall 2024, she delivered a statement at the UN on behalf of youth working worldwide for disarmament at the First Committee, which focuses on international security and peace issues. During her junior year, she completed an internship with the international humanitarian organization ACT Alliance at the UN, and in summer 2024 she was the program assistant for the Transparency, Accountability, and Participation (TAP) Network. Jasmine has taken part in many programs at Pace. Most notably, she's spent the last four years as an indispensable member of Pace's Center for Community Action and Research (CCAR). As a Pace Votes leader and Andrew Goodman Foundation Ambassador, Jasmine has facilitated voter registration from 700+ students in New York State, designed, planned, and executed community service and bi-partisan political engagement programming—including 30+ service events—and successfully advocated for accessible voting policies, such as Election Day being deemed a holiday for the 2024 election year. Academic Regalia

The history of academic dress dates back to the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 required all "Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors" of the University of Coimbra to wear gowns. In England, during the second half of the 14th century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade "excess in apparel" and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. It is still a question whether academic dress finds its sources chiefly in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. Gowns may have been worn for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars, while hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until replaced by the skull cap. In time, the skull cap was replaced by the mortarboard caps that are used widely today.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume was formed to establish a suitable code of academic dress for the colleges and universities of the United States. The academic costume code recognizes three types of gowns, usually black. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. The gown for the master's degree has long, closed sleeves with the arc of a circle near the bottom. A doctor's gown is faced with velvet, and has full, round, open sleeves bearing three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The velvet facing and bars may either be black or the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. The hood is made of a material identical to the gown and is lined in the official academic color of the institution conferring the degree. When the institution has more than one color, the chevron is used to introduce the second color. For Pace University, the official colors found in the hood are blue and gold. Colored velvet or velveteen binds the hood and indicates the subject to which the degree pertains.

In Recognition of Pace University Student Veterans

Pace University remains committed to providing high-quality and affordable education to our veteran students who have served our nation with honor and distinction. We feel privileged to have you as members of the Pace Community, now and in the future. We know that your contributions have enriched our academic and student life beyond measure. We recognize your service and sacrifice and wish you the very best in your future personal and career endeavors.

Our graduating student veterans are distinguished by the cords that indicate the branch of service that they served within the United States Armed Forces.

Traditional Symbols

In addition to the regalia and finery customarily worn by University faculty and officers, formal academic ceremonies often include colorful signs and symbols representing the history and traditions of university life as well as specific aspects of the university being celebrated.

Flags

At Pace University ceremonies, in addition to the flags of the United States, the state of New York, and of the University, the president is represented by a swallow-tail flag of a blue field with a gold border bearing the University seal in pale blue, ringed by the inscription "Office of the President."

Each school/college within the University (College of Health Professions, Dyson College of Arts and Sciences, Elisabeth Haub School of Law, Lubin School of Business, Sands College of Performing Arts, School of Education, and Seidenberg School of Computer Science and Information Systems) is signified by a blue and gold banner with the school/college name and University logo.

Maces

The mace was developed as an armor-crushing weapon in the 13th century. Battle axes and maces were formidable chivalric tools of combat and warfare. They became symbols of authority, commanding attention and respect for the bearer, and were associated with those responsible for protecting the king's person. By the 16th century, maces were ornately designed and decorated with jewels and precious metals, often crafted with elegant architectural motifs.

At Pace University, the dean for students carries two maces. One is a replica of a Gothic battle mace with a head formed by five flanges, topped by a fluted conical finial. The rondel consists of a rusticated wood shaft attached to a metal cylindrical base, all of which is brass plated and inscribed with the words "Pace University." The mace was introduced in 1968 at the first commencement held on the Pleasantville Campus. The second mace was first used in 1927 at commencement exercises of Good Counsel College, which became the College of White Plains and which was consolidated in 1975 with Pace University. The brass and wood mace is topped by a sphere and a formée cross with a garnet at its center. The rondel, consisting of two brass sections separated by a ribbed wooden grip, has a sphere at its base, which bears the inscription "Pace University."

University marshals carry batons that represent the schools/colleges of the University. The University seal is mounted on each end of the baton, which is made of American walnut. The name of each person who has served as dean of the school/college is engraved on a brass plate affixed to the school/college baton.

Verge

The verge, an elongated mace or staff carried by the grand marshal, is made of Honduran rosewood. It is topped by a replica of a bronze-coated copper globe made in 1510, which is the earliest existing representation depicting the discoveries of Christopher Columbus in the Western Hemisphere. Beneath the globe, each Pace campus is represented by ribbons of the campus color: green for New York City, blue for Pleasantville, and red for White Plains. The upper section of the shaft is inlaid with rare woods representing the four reaches of the world: ebony, teak, olive, and oak.

The Centennial Medallion (retired)

The medallion was struck in commemoration of the University's Centennial in 2006. Both the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the University President wore the Centennial Medallion, which is made of bronze and layered with silver plate. The face of the medallion is the Pace University seal and the reverse bears the engraved image of the Centennial mark.

The Centennial Staff

The University President carries an ornate staff that was crafted in 2006 to commemorate the University's Centennial. The Centennial Medallion set in brass tops the staff, which is almost six feet in height and made of solid wood.
