MEAL PLAN OPTION INFORMATION

- All full-time students receive a meal plan
- Incoming First-year, Sophomore, & Junior students receive the Setter's 10 plan
- Commuters receive the declining balance commuter meal plan
- There are upgrade meal plan options available

CHECK MEAL PLAN BALANCE

- Get a receipt at the register
- o <u>Check Card Balance</u>
- Download the Pace Mobile app and, under the One Card tab, you can check your card information, meal plan balance, and add Voluntary (Dawg) Dollars or Swipes.



DAWG DOLLARS & SWIPES

Voluntary (Dawg) Dollars are funds that are not originally part of the meal plan. They can be added as a supplement and never expire, functioning in the same way as Flex Dollars.

Voluntary (Dawg) Swipes are used only in the cafeteria and function the same way as meal exchange swipes.

How to add Dawg Dollars & Swipes:

- o Add Dawg Dollars & Swipes
- Student Accounts (*In-person*)
- In the cafeteria with a Dining Service Manager (*Pleasantville*)
