
# Adding and Editing a Stats Component

- After clicking Edit on your webpage, scroll to the bottom of your page.
- Under Components, click Add Stats.



Or, if you are editing an existing Stats Component, Click the Edit button next to the component.





- Each stat section is called a **Stat Card** and each Stat Card has two fields. **Stat Amount** and **Description**.
- You can add a title above your stats to give them context, and you can add **three Stat Cards**

- The **Stat Amount** is usually represented by a number and the **Description** tells the user what that number represents. For instance, you might add the year that Pace was founded (1906) in the Stat Amount field, and add something like The Year Pace Was Founded in the Description field.
- You can add two more Stat Cards, by clicking the Add Stats Card to Stats button.

- You can also use text for your Stat Amount field.
- For instance, in the sample below we are using the word **Locations** as the **Stat Amount** and telling users in the **Description** field where the three campuses of Pace University are located.





• You can change the order of your **Stat Cards** by using the **Change Order icon**  $\Rightarrow$  to the left of the card.



• For instance, if you wanted card three to appear in slot two, you can drag and drop it below card one.



• To apply this change, **click save** at the bottom of your edit page.



• After you clicking Save, your stats will now appear in the new order.





- To update a specific Stat Card with new information, click edit on your page.
- Scroll down to the **Components** section and **click Edit next to the Stats Component** which will open up the component to reveal your three **Stat Cards**.
