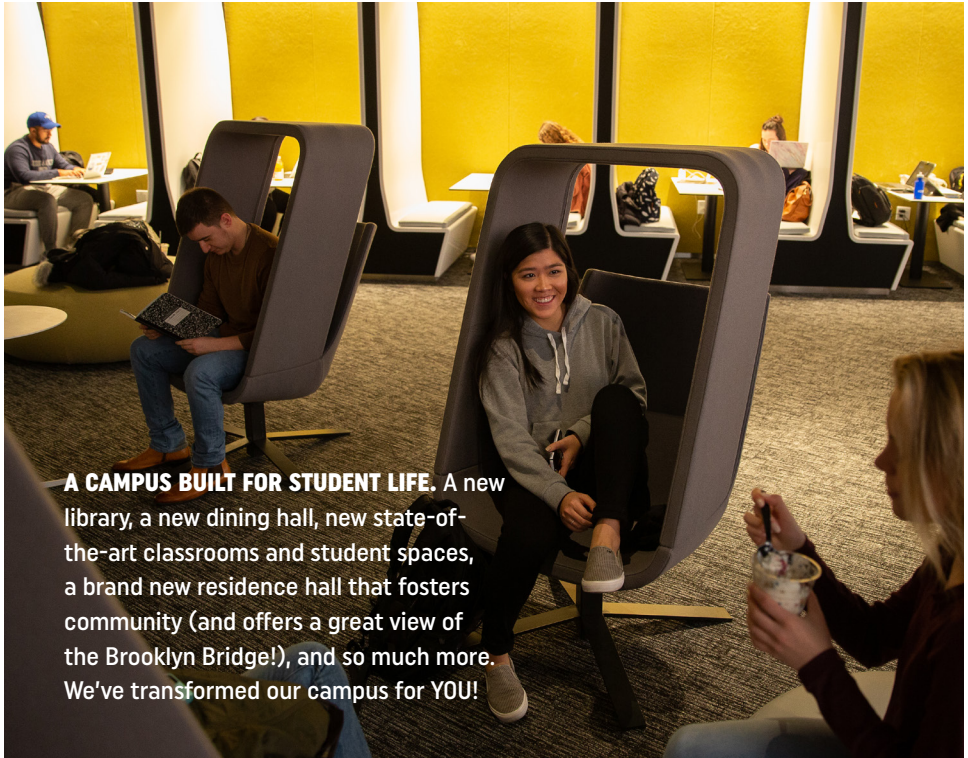

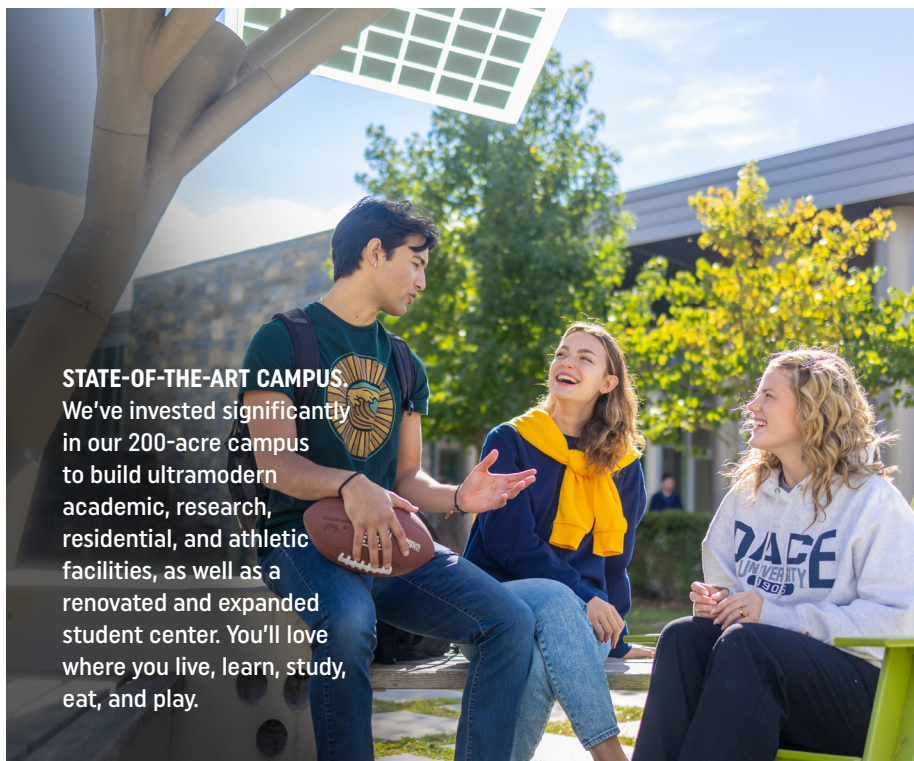

VETERANS TUITION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Pace University offers a scholarship program for veterans that is the first of its kind, started even before the Yellow Ribbon Program was established almost 20 years ago. Pace's Veterans Tuition Scholarship Program is open to veterans from all branches of the United States Armed Forces who served in Afghanistan and/or Iraq since September 11, 2001. The new program grants eligible veterans a scholarship covering half the cost (50%) of Pace tuition for all Veterans (both new and current) for all undergraduate programs and most graduate programs. This award is only applicable to the fall and spring semesters.

The scholarship is open to all admitted veterans who provide a copy of their DD-214 form with the following designations:

- Global War in Terrorism Expeditionary Medal
- Afghanistan Campaign Medal
- Iraqi Campaign Medal

YELLOW RIBBON PROGRAM

As an unlimited **Yellow Ribbon School**, Pace University is proud to support the Post-9/11 GI Bill*. The Yellow Ribbon Program can help you pay for higher out-of-state, private school, foreign school, or graduate school tuition and fees that the Post-9/11 GI Bill doesn't cover. The Yellow Ribbon Program must be used in conjunction with the Post-9/11 GI Bill and to be eligible, a student must qualify for the Post-9/11 GI Bill at the 100% benefit level.

Qualifications:

- Served at least an aggregate period of 36 months of active duty after September 10, 2001.
- Honorably discharged from active duty for a service-connected disability after serving at least 30 continuous days after September 10, 2001.
- Dependents of eligible veterans qualified for Transfer of Entitlement under the Post-9/11 GI Bill.

STEPS TO ENROLLMENT

1. Complete your online application and submit supporting documents.
Veteran Fee Waiver is applied for online applications.
2. Contact the VA Educational Hotline for benefit authorization to determine your qualifying educational benefits at (888) 442-4551 or visit **the VA Education website**.
3. For all inquiries concerning Active Duty, Reserve, National Guard, and Veteran education benefits and tuition assistance (TA), contact Pace's Veteran Services for a pre-enrollment benefit evaluation at **veteranaffairs@pace.edu**.
Once you have officially registered for courses and finalized your course schedule, visit osapaperless.pace.edu and complete the "Veterans Request for Enrollment Certification" to provide the required authorization to submit your enrollment certification to the Department of Veteran Affairs.
4. **File your FAFSA**
(New York City-002791 / Westchester-002792).
Track the status of your application **by visiting the Pace Portal**.
5. **Submit your Joint Services Transcripts**.
