- .Have you arranged a place to live during your stay in the U.S.?

Ties to Your Home Country

- .Explain your connections to your home country (e.g., family, job, community activities).
- .Why do you plan to return to your home country after finishing your studies?

.How will you use your new English skills when you return (e.g., job promotion, starting a business, continuing your education)?
