## **Explanatory Note**

The ICJ Advisory Opinion was requested by the UN General Assembly (Res. 77/276) and the International Court of Justice Advisory Opinion was delivered on July 23, 2025. Responding to the Advisory Opinion is urgent, and none of the States or other parties before the court such as IUCN, knew when the Advisory Opinion would be given, or what rulings it would present.
