Apply for Tuition Assistance with FAFSA

To be considered for financial aid, you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). **File your FAFSA by February 15 to receive a \$2,000 scholarship.** Please complete the FAFSA for only the Pace campus you are interested in attending.

Steps to Complete Your FAFSA

1. Create Your FSA ID NOW.

Visit **the FAFSA website** (This will be your FAFSA username and password). A parent must create an FSA ID if they don't have one already.

2. Gather Your Documents NOW.

Student and parent Social Security numbers; Driver's license (if applicable); W-2 forms and other income records

3. Complete Your FAFSA.

Follow the prompts and enter information carefully. Invite parent to complete their section. List Pace University in your school lists. Choose New York City or Pleasantville campus. If unsure, only enter one code.

- **New York City Campus Code: 002791**

- **Pleasantville Campus Code: 002792**

4. Review and Submit Your FAFSA.

5. Check Your Email

for your Student Aid Report from the Department of Education. Respond quickly to any requests for information.

File by February 15 to receive a \$2,000 scholarship every year you file.
