

Uniform Bar Examination (UBE)

The UBE consists of the **Multistate Bar Examination (MBE)**, the Multistate Essay Examination (MEE) and Multistate Performance Test (MPT).

Subjects tested on the MEE (Subject Matter Outline from the National Conference of Bar Examiners):

As of July 2026 through February 2028, the MEE subjects will include all MBE Subjects + the following subjects:

Business Associations, including:
Agency and Partnership; and
Corporations and LLCs (Limited Liability Companies).

While no longer tested on the MEEs, Family Law and Trusts and Estates “will be tested regularly” on the MPT (Multistate Performance Test).

As of July, 2028, the NextGen UBE will be administered, which examination does not include an MEE component.
