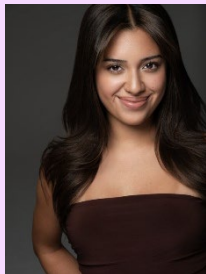
Alex Aether (they/she)

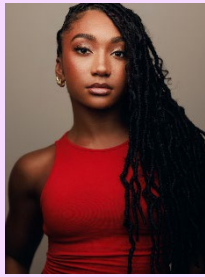
Bella Boles (she/her)

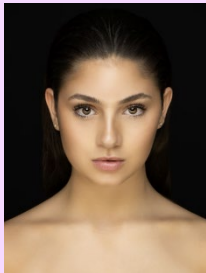


Ryan Edge (he/him)

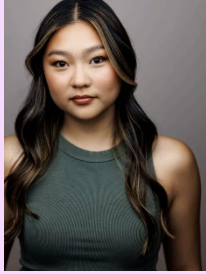
Ella Howell (she/her)

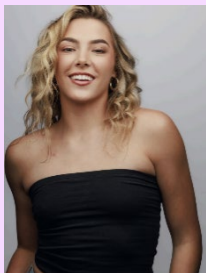
Tristan laneiro (he/him)

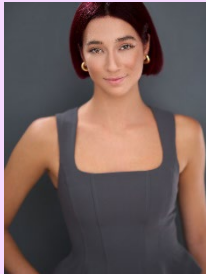

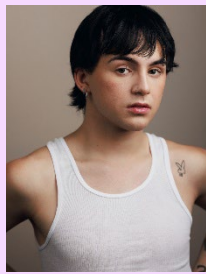

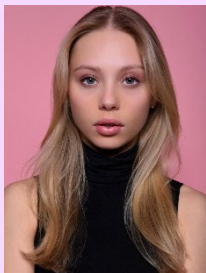
Lily Levine (she/her)

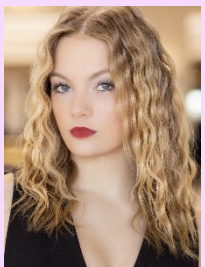

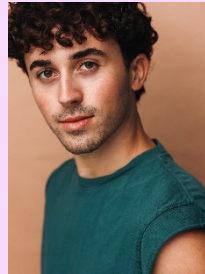

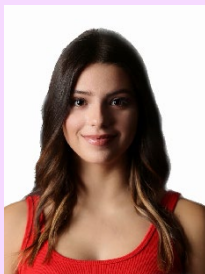
Brett Rule (she/her)

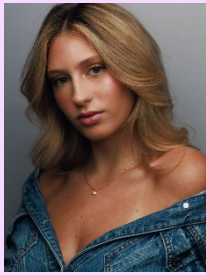
Lars Schaefer (he/him)

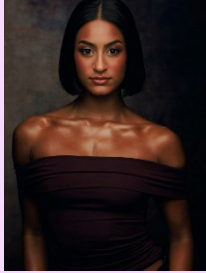
Natalia Sculla (she/her)

Meet the Creative Team

Scott Jovovich (he/him/his) - Director; Choreographer "Birth of the Blues"

Mr. Jovovich was a Principal dancer with The Joffrey Ballet, The Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre, The Northern Ballet Theatre, The Universal Ballet, Ballet Arizona, and the Lar Lubovitch Dance Company. His repertoire includes leading roles in ballets by many of the world's foremost choreographers. He was featured in the Broadway Musicals, "JEROME ROBBINS BROADWAY" and "FOSSE", as well as "CAROUSEL" and "ONCE UPON A MATTRESS". He has appeared in numerous TV commercials and soaps, performed on the 1989, 1997, and 1999 TONY AWARDS Broadcasts, THE ROSIE O'DONNELL SHOW, and was a guest on "MONDAY NIGHT SPORTS". Jovovich has directed and choreographed for nightclubs, musical theater, ballet, commercials and industrials. As a teacher, Mr. Jovovich is in high demand as a guest teacher around the world, and has been on the faculty of The Joffrey Ballet School, The Shirley Rock School, The Pittsburgh Ballet Theatre School, The Hong Kong Academy for the Performing Arts, The New York City Dance Alliance, The University of the Arts in Phila and is currently an Assistant Professor and Associate Program Head with the Commercial Dance BFA at Sands College of Performing Arts. Jovovich is one a small group of people authorized by The Verdon Fosse Legacy, to teach and stage Bob Fosse's works. He served as a voting member of The Chita Awards, which honors Dance in Theater and Film.

Jared Alexander - Choreographer "Freefall"

Jared Alexander, a Hudson Valley native, is a New York City-based tap artist and multimedia-curiosity-inspired creative. A 2019 alum from Pace University's Commercial Dance BFA program, Jared's artistic view connects life experiences and an obsession with music to various dance genres, forming his unique tap dance style. Alexander, a 2021 DLNY choreographer alum, has presented his own work at ArtBath NYC (2025), Asbury Park Dance Festival (2024), Hamptons Dance Project (2024 & 2025), Asbury Book Cooperative "After Dark" series (2023 & 2024), For the Love & Autumn in New York for Pace University's Dance Program (2021), as well as collaborating with Naomi Funaki for Bryant Park's Picnic Summer Series (2024), Dre Torres & Gerson Lanza at Little Island Summer Dance Festival NYC (2021-2022), and Tomoe "Beasty" Carr for Artists at the Center at New York City Center (2023) with a world premiere of "Interlaced." Alexander has professionally worked under Ayodele Casel and Torya Beard for multiple projects including: The Remix (2025), Rooted (2024), an All Arts documentary, Artists at the Center, City Center (2023), Rooted Tour (2023-24), Chasing Magic (2022-2024) at The Joyce Theater, Spoleto Dance Festival & McCarter Theatre; Dance Against Cancer, Lincoln Center (2023); MET Gala (2022), Fords Gala (2022), and a Warner Bros. Project in Bordeaux, France. Jared has worked under Caleb Teicher & Co. in Bzzz (2023) at The Joyce Theater, Lincoln Center, Jacobs Pillow, and Artists at the Center (2023) in collaboration with Naomi Funaki.
