### overview

Pace University, located in lower Manhattan in the heart of the Financial District, is an intellectual and cultural hub of one of New York's most dynamic and hyper-urban areas. Urban Offsets is a global leader in developing sustainable urban-based climate resiliency programs for universities and corporations. In this project Pace University and Urban Offsets partnered together to purchase carbon offsets certified by the Climate Action Reserve and to support the New York Restoration Project's (NYRP) spring 2017 tree giveaway program throughout the five boroughs.

### impact

Community Carbon Projects like this one combine the emission offsetting power of carbon offsets with climate resilience programs such as targeted community tree planting. For this program, NYRP and Urban Offsets will utilize tree inventory technologies to regularly measure the health of each tree over the life of the program. Enhancements to NYRP's tree giveaway services were partially funded through the sale of Climate Action Reserve offsets to Pace University.

### opportunities

This project provided NYC residents the opportunity to adopt and care for 150 trees in 2017. These trees, and other NYRP tree planting programs, will need your support again through the purchase of carbon offsets in 2018.
