Honorary Degree Citation

Doctor of Humane Letters

Lester Holt

Lester Holt is one of America's most decorated and trusted broadcast journalists, currently serving as anchor of *Dateline NBC*. For a decade, he served as anchor and managing editor of *NBC Nightly News*, guiding the nation through some of its most consequential moments, from presidential elections and natural disasters to acts of terrorism and global crises.

Holt is renowned for his on-the-ground reporting, traveling to the scenes of history as it unfolds. He reported from Israel in the immediate aftermath of the October 7 attack as the only broadcast news anchor on the ground during the first two full weeks of the conflict, from Ukraine following Russia's invasion in 2022, from Tehran where he secured rare access to Iranian diplomats, and from cities across Europe following major terrorist attacks. His exclusive interview with President Trump in May 2017—in which the president linked the firing of FBI Director James Comey to the Russia investigation—stands as one of the most consequential broadcast interviews of the modern era. He also conducted the final interview with President Joe Biden before he withdrew from the 2024 presidential race, and he moderated the first presidential debate of 2016, the most-watched presidential debate in American history.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Holt anchored weekly NBC primetime specials and launched *Nightly News: Kids Edition*, an Emmy-nominated digital newscast designed to inform and educate children during an especially uncertain time. Over recent years, he has become the leading broadcast journalist on criminal justice reform, spending three days embedded inside Louisiana State Penitentiary and moderating the first-ever televised town hall from the maximum-security Sing Sing Correctional Facility.

Holt has been recognized with multiple Emmy Awards, the Edward R. Murrow Lifetime Achievement Award, the Walter Cronkite Award for Excellence in Journalism, the National Press Club Fourth Estate Award, and numerous other honors. He will be inducted into the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences' 2026 Chicago Silver Circle and receive the 2026 Fred Dressler Leadership Award from Syracuse University's Newhouse School of Public Communications. He studied government at California State University, Sacramento, and began his television journalism career in New York City in 1981.

For his decades of courageous and consequential journalism, his steadfast commitment to truth and public accountability, and his profound contributions to an informed and engaged citizenry, Pace University is honored to confer upon Lester Holt the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Honorary Degree Citation

Doctor of Science

Mitchell Katz, MD

Mitchell Katz is the President and Chief Executive Officer of NYC Health + Hospitals, the largest municipal healthcare system in the United States, encompassing eleven acute care hospitals, five skilled nursing facilities, dozens of community health centers, a home care agency, and MetroPlus Health, the system's insurance plan.

Since his appointment in 2018, Dr. Katz has dramatically expanded access to care for New York's most vulnerable residents. He created NYC Care, a universal health access program now serving more than one hundred thousand uninsured New Yorkers, modernized the system's electronic health records infrastructure, grew its nursing workforce, launched innovative street outreach programs for homeless New Yorkers, and led a landmark financial turnaround by enrolling more patients in health insurance and strengthening billing practices. During the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Katz provided strategic guidance to Mayor Bill de Blasio while directing the public health system's response to a patient surge that peaked at 3,700 simultaneously hospitalized individuals—tripling ICU capacity across all eleven hospitals. NYC Health + Hospitals led the city's Test and Trace operation and administered more than 1.3 million COVID-19 vaccines.

Before coming to New York, Dr. Katz served as Director of the Los Angeles County Health Agency, overseeing a seven-billion-dollar enterprise of twenty-eight thousand employees integrating health services, public health, and mental health. As Director of the LA County Department of Health Services, he created a robust ambulatory care network, empaneled more than 350,000 patients to primary care homes, and moved more than four thousand medically complex patients from hospitals and emergency departments into independent housing, restoring their dignity while eliminating costly unnecessary care. Earlier, he served for thirteen years as Director and Health Officer of the San Francisco Department of Health, where he championed needle exchange, created Healthy San Francisco, banned tobacco sales at pharmacies, and secured ballot measures to rebuild two of the city's major public hospitals.

A graduate of Yale College and Harvard Medical School, Dr. Katz completed his internal medicine residency at UCSF and was an RWJ Clinical Scholar. He continues to practice as a primary care physician, seeing patients at NYC Health + Hospitals/Gouverneur on the Lower East Side of Manhattan. He is the Deputy Editor of JAMA Internal Medicine, an elected member of the National Academy of Sciences, and a recipient of the Los Angeles County Medical Association's Healthcare Champion of the Year award.

For his visionary leadership in public health, his tireless commitment to providing dignified care for underserved communities, and his extraordinary service to the people of New York City and beyond, Pace University is honored to confer upon Dr. Mitchell Katz the degree of Doctor of Science, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Pedro Rivera '12

Pedro Rivera is an Emmy and LA Press Club Award–winning journalist who co-anchors *Eyewitness News This Morning* and *Eyewitness News Mornings at 10* on WABC in New York City—the station where his broadcasting career first took root.

Born in the Bronx, Pedro Rivera earned his Bachelor of Science in Communications from Pace University's Dyson College of Arts and Sciences in Pleasantville, where he interned at WABC-TV and had the formative opportunity to interview sports legends Bob Gibson, Joe Torre, and Ron Guidry. That early experience ignited a career that has taken him from the newsrooms of Hartford and Fort Smith to the anchor desks of Sacramento and Los Angeles, and back home to New York. Before rejoining WABC, Rivera anchored weeknight broadcasts for KTLA 5 News in Los Angeles, where he reported on the Robb Elementary School mass shooting in Uvalde, Texas, and the Camp Fire in Northern California—the deadliest and most destructive wildfire in state history.

Throughout his career, Rivera has remained as committed to his community as he is to his craft. He serves on the advisory board for Dyson College and is co-chair of the Afro-Latino Task Force for the National Association for Hispanic Journalists, advocating for greater diversity and representation in media.

For his excellence in broadcast journalism, his dedication to keeping communities informed through moments of crisis and celebration alike, and his enduring loyalty to Pace University and the city that shaped him, Pace University is honored to confer upon Pedro Rivera the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Honorary Degree Citation

Doctor of Laws

Honorable Francesca E. Connolly '82

The Honorable Francesca E. Connolly serves as an Associate Justice of the Appellate Division of the New York State Supreme Court, Second Judicial Department—the busiest intermediate state appellate court in the nation. Appointed in 2016 by Governor Andrew Cuomo, Justice Connolly was named to the Second Department's Constitutional Bench by Governor Kathy Hochul in 2022. She is a senior member of the court and serves as a Justice Presiding. Justice Connolly was the first graduate of Pace Law School to be appointed to the Appellate Division.

In 2024, she served by designation as an Associate Judge of the New York Court of Appeals.

Justice Connolly was first appointed to the New York State Supreme Court in 2009 by Governor David Paterson and was elected to a fourteen-year term in 2010, with reelection in 2023. She has served as Supervising Judge of the Matrimonial Part and has presided over the Environmental Claims Part, Compliance Part, and an Individual Assignment Part in Westchester County Supreme Court. From 2014 to 2016, she also sat on the Appellate Term for the Ninth and Tenth Judicial Districts.

Justice Connolly began her judicial career in 2006, when she became the first woman elected Ossining Town Justice, serving until 2009. She also served as Acting City Court Judge in Mount Vernon and Yonkers. Her public service includes five years on the Ossining Town Council, three as Deputy Town Supervisor, and prior service on the Town Planning Board. She serves on the Board of Directors of the Friends of Rockefeller State Park Preserve.

Justice Connolly lectures frequently at CLE programs—including for the New York State Judicial Institute—and has authored numerous published opinions. She serves on the New York State Advisory Committee on Civil Practice. Before joining the bench, she practiced complex civil litigation for twenty-seven years in state and federal courts.

Justice Connolly earned her BA, magna cum laude, from the State University of New York at Albany in 1979 and her JD from Pace University School of Law in 1982.

Today, for her distinguished leadership in public service, for her unwavering dedication to pursuing justice with integrity, and for her enduring commitment to the legal profession and her alma mater, the Elisabeth Haub School of Law at Pace University is proud to confer upon the Honorable Francesca E. Connolly the degree of Doctor of Laws, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Peter Muller

Peter Muller is the Founder and Chief Executive Officer of PDT Partners, LLC, a leading quantitative investment firm that spun out of Morgan Stanley in 2012.

Throughout his career, Muller has embodied a rare and generative intersection of analytical rigor and creative expression. His published research spans financial optimization, mortgage prepayments, and equity valuation models, and his work has helped define the field of quantitative investing. He received his Bachelor of Arts in Mathematics with honors from Princeton University.

Beyond finance, Muller has devoted his energy and resources to causes that expand access to the arts and sciences. He serves on the board of Math for America, an organization dedicated to supporting and retaining exceptional mathematics and science teachers in public schools. As the Founder and Board President of the Live Music Society, he champions the survival of small and independent music venues—vital cultural anchors in communities across the country. A pianist and singer-songwriter, Muller has released seven albums of original music and performs regularly with his band. He is also an accomplished cruciverbalist, publishing crossword puzzles in major national publications, and a devoted philanthropist across a wide range of civic causes.

For his pioneering contributions to quantitative finance, his passionate investment in mathematics education and the arts, and his demonstration that intellectual rigor and creative spirit are not opposing forces but complementary ones, Pace University is honored to confer upon Peter Muller the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

Judith M. Watson, RN, BSN, MPH, HD '94 '82

Judith M. Watson is the Chief Executive Officer of Westchester Community Health Center, a nine-site Federally Qualified Health Center providing high-quality, accessible care to underserved populations across Westchester County.

Judith immigrated to the United States from Jamaica at the age of seven and was raised in White Plains, New York. After graduating from White Plains High School, she enlisted in the United States Army, serving three years on active duty stationed at Ford Island, Hawaii, followed by seven years in the Army Reserves, ultimately achieving the rank of Sergeant E-5. She credits her military service with instilling the discipline, work ethic, and deep commitment to service that have defined her remarkable career.

Judith earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from the Lienhard School of Nursing at Pace University, a foundation upon which she has built more than three decades of transformative community health leadership. She went on to earn her Master of Public Health from New York Medical College. Her healthcare career began in 1994 at the Greenburgh Health Center, now part of the Westchester Community Health Center system, where she has dedicated over thirty-one years to advancing the health and well-being of those who need it most. She has served in progressively senior leadership roles, including Executive Director of the Greenburgh site and Chief Operating Officer of the Mount Vernon Neighborhood Health Center, before assuming her current role as Chief Executive Officer. Judith is deeply engaged in the communities she serves, sitting on fourteen community and nonprofit boards, including the Board of Westchester Medical Center. Judith also now currently serves as the board Chairman for the Community Health Care Association of New York State (CHCANYS).

For her distinguished service to public health, her enduring commitment to expanding access to care for underserved communities, and her inspiring example as a leader, a veteran, and a proud alumna of Pace University, Pace University is honored to confer upon Judith M. Watson the degree of Doctor of Humane Letters, *honoris causa*, with all the rights and privileges pertaining thereunto.

The Opportunitas in Action Award, bestowed by the president of Pace University, recognizes a leader who has made innovative, positive contributions to the community in the spirit of Pace's motto, Opportunitas.

Cedric Bobo

Cedric Bobo is the Founder of Project Destined, a leading social impact platform that provides training in financial literacy, entrepreneurship, and real estate. Project Destined partners with corporations, schools, and nonprofits to deliver training through its proprietary e-learning platform and live courses. To date, the organization has trained more than 30,000 students, including high school students, college students, and military veterans. Scholars emerge with the skills, confidence, experiences, and network needed to secure competitive entry-level careers and become stakeholders in their communities.

Under Cedric's leadership, Project Destined has partnered with more than 250 leading companies and institutions and has received multiple national honors for its impact, including recognition on Commercial Observer's prestigious Power 100 list.

Cedric grew up in Memphis, Tennessee, and earned his undergraduate degree from the University of Tennessee before receiving his Master of Business Administration from Harvard Business School. He went on to build a distinguished 20-year career as an investor and investment banker, including more than a decade at The Carlyle Group, where he helped commit over \$2 billion of equity capital across investments. Earlier in his career, he worked at DLJ Merchant Banking in London and McCown De Leeuw.

New York City Kenan Awards for Teaching Excellence

Pradeep Gopalakrishna, PhD

*Professor and Department Chair, Marketing
Lubin School of Business*

Professor Pradeep Gopalakrishna is Professor and Chair of the Marketing Department in the Lubin School of Business. His teaching career at Pace University spans more than 30 years, during which he has taught across all levels of the curriculum. His current courses include Principles of Marketing, Driving Marketing Performance in the MBA program, and the Foundation Seminar in Marketing at the doctoral level.

Professor Gopalakrishna has chaired numerous doctoral dissertations and has played a central role in shaping the academic development of doctoral students. He is the founder of the Sports Marketing program on the Pleasantville campus and, for more than fifteen years, has organized experiential learning opportunities connecting students with front-office executives from organizations including the New York Mets and Brooklyn Nets.

A strong advocate for experiential learning, he integrates guest speakers and real-world perspectives into his teaching. His research focuses on market orientation, consumer behavior, and the intersection of psychology and marketing. His work has been published in leading journals, including the *Journal of Business Research*, *International Journal of Advertising*, *Management International Review*, *Journal of Retailing and Consumer Services*, *Rutgers Business Review*, and the *Journal of Global Marketing*. He has also developed case studies to support marketing pedagogy.

In addition to his academic responsibilities, Professor Gopalakrishna is actively involved in external initiatives through the Center for Global Business at Lubin. He earned a BS in Mechanical Engineering from Bangalore University, and an MBA and PhD in Marketing from the University of North Texas.

Courtney Gosnell, PhD

*Associate Professor, Psychology
Dyson College of Arts and Sciences*

Professor Courtney Gosnell is Associate Professor of Psychology and Director of Undergraduate Psychology in the Dyson College of Arts and Sciences. Over the past decade at Pace University, she has taught a wide range of undergraduate courses, with a focus on student engagement, community building, experiential learning, and real-world applications.

Professor Gosnell actively incorporates research into her teaching. She regularly teaches the Experimental Psychology capstone course, guiding students through the development of original research projects that culminate in conference presentations. Many of her students continue their work in her research lab, and she has mentored more than 40 undergraduate students, with her mentees earning 18 student-faculty research grants at Pace.

She has received the Pace Classroom-Based Undergraduate Research Experience Award in support of first-year research initiatives. She also developed a Psychology majors' section of UNV 101 linked to an introductory course to foster community among first-year students. An advocate for accessible learning, she has supported the adoption of Open Educational Resources through both her teaching and her service on the University's OER Committee, contributing to a team recognized with the President's Award for Outstanding Contribution.

Her research focuses on social support and goal pursuit within close relationships. In addition, she has published and presented on teaching and pedagogy and has served on the Early Career Psychologist Committee for the Society for the Teaching of Psychology.

Eugina Song, MFA

Professor Eugina Song is an artist, educator, and art director who teaches painting and drawing at Pace University. Her work explores the intersection of pictorial and physical space through material and conceptual processes.

Her teaching emphasizes strong technical foundations alongside critical inquiry and the development of sustainable studio practices. She holds a BFA from Cornell University and an MFA from Hunter College.

Professor Song's work has been presented in New York and internationally, including a solo exhibition at Hyacinth Gallery and group exhibitions at the Athens Cultural Center, Walter Wickiser Gallery, and KIAF.

In addition to her studio and teaching practice, she serves as an Art Director at VOX VANGUARD, contributing to game design and immersive performances across the United Kingdom, Hong Kong, and beyond.

Laurice Nemetz

Laurice Nemetz is an adjunct faculty member in the College of Health Professions and a scholar and practitioner in movement and anatomy. She is the author of *The Myofascial System in Form and Movement* (Handspring Publishing, 2023) and a contributor to several major publications, including *The Anatomy of Yoga Coloring Book*, *The Creative Arts Therapies Manual*, and *Fascia, Function, and Medical Applications*, as well as articles in journals such as the *Journal of Anatomy*.

Nemetz has presented internationally at institutions and organizations including Harvard Medical School, the University of Oxford, the American Association for Anatomy, and the Fascia Research Congress. Her workshops on movement and anatomy have been held throughout the United States and abroad.

She has taught at Pace University for more than 20 years and has received multiple recognitions, including the President's Award for Outstanding Contribution. She previously held a visiting associate professorship in the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at Rush University Medical Center.

A licensed Creative Arts Therapist (LCAT) and certified yoga therapist (C-IAYT), Nemetz's work spans several decades and integrates movement, anatomy, and education. She teaches anatomy dissection labs with KNMLABS and has participated in international research initiatives, including serving as a lead dissector for the Fascia Net Plastination Project in Germany.

She is currently pursuing a PhD in Contemporary Human Anatomy Education at Eastern Virginia Medical School, with a focus on visual rhetoric and anatomy.

Distinguished Professor

Kimberly Collica-Cox, PhD

Professor, Criminal Justice

Dyson College of Arts and Sciences

Professor Kimberly Collica-Cox is a professor in the Criminal Justice Department at Pace University and Director of Dyson College's Jail-Based Services. With a career spanning over 28 years in correctional work, she is a leading authority on rehabilitative and reintegrative initiatives in the carceral setting. Professor Collica-Cox holds a PhD and MPhil from the CUNY Graduate Center, along with a master's degree and bachelor's degree from John Jay College, and is currently completing a master's degree in mental health counseling at Pace University.

A prolific scholar, her research covers correctional programming, the experiences and career trajectories of women executives in corrections, and animal-assisted interventions, among other corrections-based topics. She serves as the University's only Inside-Out instructor and leads innovative initiatives such as Parenting, Prison & Pups—which integrates animal-assisted therapy and Pace undergraduate students as teaching assistants into parenting curricula—and Puppies on the Block, a fostering program for women and men who are incarcerated.

Also serving as a subject matter expert in corrections, she is a certified American Correctional Association (ACA) and Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) auditor. A dedicated advocate for evidence-based reform, Professor Collica-Cox focuses on translating complex research into actionable policy, championing transformative programs that offer meaningful pathways for change.

Associate Professor, Marketing

Professor Kathryn (Kathy) Winsted is a distinguished educator, researcher, and mentor currently serving as an associate professor of Marketing and Director of the Center for Student Enterprise (CSE) at Pace University. With a career defined by a commitment to experiential learning and student success, Professor Winsted plays a pivotal role in shaping the entrepreneurial landscape at Pace's Pleasantville campus.

In her capacity as Director of the CSE, Professor Winsted provides hands-on mentorship for approximately 80 students who operate five unique campus businesses. Since 2010, she has been a tireless advocate for student-led ventures, encouraging undergraduates to pitch innovative ideas and providing the structural support necessary to bring those concepts to fruition. Currently, she is assisting a new group of students in launching a sixth campus business. Her leadership involves meeting weekly with management teams to ensure smooth operations and offering essential administrative guidance. She also oversees the professional development of these student-entrepreneurs by helping them draft annual reports and procedure manuals, conducting individual performance reviews, and organizing semesterly board meetings where students present their financial statements and ideas to stakeholders.

Professor Winsted's teaching philosophy is rooted in high-engagement practices. For her Introduction to Business course, she developed a proprietary series of single-session micro-simulations supported by custom business math assignments and Excel-based decision-making tools. She also pioneered a learning community that integrates introductory business and computer information systems classes, allowing students to build Excel worksheets in one course and apply them to simulations in the other. In her digital marketing courses, she bridges the gap between theory and practice by securing two real-world clients each spring for whom students develop comprehensive digital strategies. Furthermore, she ensures her students are prepared for the modern workforce by helping them earn various professional certifications.

Her academic research focuses on service excellence, entrepreneurship, and innovative pedagogy. Her work has been widely published in prominent journals, including the *Journal of Retailing*, *Journal of Services Marketing*, the *European Journal of Marketing*, and the *Journal of Case Studies*.

Professor Winsted's impressive credentials include a PhD in Marketing from the University of Colorado, a Master of Public Administration from Harvard, and a bachelor's degree in economics from Middlebury College.

A dedicated member of the academic community, Professor Winsted has served on the Middlebury College Board of Trustees and various leadership and trustee committees at Pace, including terms as Chair of the Lubin Faculty Council and Director of the Pace Business Honors Program. Seidenberg School of Computer Science and Information Systems

Professor Matthew Ganis is a technology leader, educator, and innovator whose career spans more than four decades in computing and networked systems. He joined the Seidenberg School of Computer Science and Information Systems as a full-time faculty member following a 41-year career at IBM.

During his tenure at IBM, Professor Ganis contributed to the design and deployment of the company's internal data networks during the early stages of networked computing. He played a key role in the development of one of the first firewall systems, helping to establish foundational practices in cybersecurity. His work in large-scale distributed systems supported the development of global data center infrastructures, including those used for the Sydney, Atlanta, and Nagano Olympic Games.

Later in his career, he led efforts to scale Agile software development practices across IBM's global development teams, influencing how software is developed and delivered at scale.

In parallel with his industry work, Professor Ganis has maintained a long-standing commitment to education. He served as an adjunct faculty member at Pace University for 35 years, teaching courses in computer science and astronomy. He is recognized for his ability to make complex technical concepts accessible and relevant to students.

A three-time alumnus of Pace University, he earned a BS in Computer Science, an MBA in Information Systems, and a Doctor of Professional Studies in Computing. He also holds a master's degree in astronomy from the University of Western Sydney.

Academic Regalia

The history of academic dress dates back to the early days of the oldest universities. A statute of 1321 required all "Doctors, Licentiates, and Bachelors" of the University of Coimbra to wear gowns. In England, during the second half of the 14th century, the statutes of certain colleges forbade "excess in apparel" and prescribed the wearing of a long gown. It is still a question whether academic dress finds its sources chiefly in ecclesiastical or in civilian dress. Gowns may have been worn for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars, while hoods seem to have served to cover the tonsured head until replaced by the skull cap. In time, the skull cap was replaced by the mortarboard caps that are used widely today.

In 1895, the Intercollegiate Bureau of Academic Costume was formed to establish a suitable code of academic dress for the colleges and universities of the United States. The academic costume code recognizes three types of gowns, usually black. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. The gown for the master's degree has long, closed sleeves with the arc of a circle near the bottom. A doctor's gown is faced with velvet, and has full, round, open sleeves bearing three bars of velvet on each sleeve. The velvet facing and bars may either be black or the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains. The hood is made of a material identical to the gown and is lined in the official academic color of the institution conferring the degree. When the institution has more than one color, the chevron is used to introduce the second color. For Pace University, the official colors found in the hood are blue and gold. Colored velvet or velveteen binds the hood and indicates the subject to which the degree pertains.

In Recognition of Pace University Student Veterans

Pace University remains committed to providing high-quality and affordable education to our veteran students who have served our nation with honor and distinction. Our graduating student veterans are distinguished by the cords that indicate the branch of service that they served within the United States Armed Forces.

Traditional Symbols

In addition to the regalia and finery customarily worn by University faculty and officers, formal academic ceremonies often include colorful signs and symbols representing the history and traditions of university life as well as specific aspects of the university being celebrated.

Flags

At Pace University ceremonies, in addition to the flags of the United States, the state of New York, and of the University, the president is represented by a swallow-tail flag of a blue field with a gold border bearing the University seal in pale blue, ringed by the inscription "Office of the President."

Each school/college within the University (College of Health Professions, Dyson College of Arts and Sciences, Elisabeth Haub School of Law, Lubin School of Business, Sands College of Performing Arts, School of Education, and Seidenberg School of Computer Science and Information Systems) is signified by a blue and gold banner with the school/college name and University logo.

Maces

The mace was developed as an armor-crushing weapon in the 13th century. Battle axes and maces were formidable chivalric tools of combat and warfare. They became symbols of authority, commanding attention and respect for the bearer, and were associated with those responsible for protecting the king's person. By the 16th century, maces were ornately designed and decorated with jewels and precious metals, often crafted with elegant architectural motifs.

At Pace University, the dean for students carries two maces. One is a replica of a Gothic battle mace with a head formed by five flanges, topped by a fluted conical finial. The rondel consists of a rusticated wood shaft attached to a metal cylindrical base, all of which is brass plated and inscribed with the words "Pace University." The mace was introduced in 1968 at the first commencement held on the Pleasantville Campus. The second mace was first used in 1927 at commencement exercises of Good Counsel College, which became the College of White Plains and which was consolidated in 1975 with Pace University. The brass and wood mace is topped by a sphere and a formée cross with a garnet at its center. The rondel, consisting of two brass sections separated by a ribbed wooden grip, has a sphere at its base, which bears the inscription "Pace University."

University marshals carry batons that represent the schools/colleges of the University. The University seal is mounted on each end of the baton, which is made of American walnut. The name of each person who has served as dean of the school/college is engraved on a brass plate affixed to the school/college baton.

Verge

The verge, an elongated mace or staff carried by the grand marshal, is made of Honduran rosewood. It is topped by a replica of a bronze-coated copper globe made in 1510, which is the earliest existing representation depicting the discoveries of Christopher Columbus in the Western Hemisphere. Beneath the globe, each Pace campus is represented by ribbons of the campus color: green for New York City, blue for Pleasantville, and red for White Plains. The upper section of the shaft is inlaid with rare woods representing the four reaches of the world: ebony, teak, olive, and oak.

The Centennial Medallion (retired)

The medallion was struck in commemoration of the University's Centennial in 2006. Both the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the University President wore the Centennial Medallion, which is made of bronze and layered with silver plate. The face of the medallion is the Pace University seal and the reverse bears the engraved image of the Centennial mark.

The Centennial Staff

The University President carries an ornate staff that was crafted in 2006 to commemorate the University's Centennial.

The Centennial Medallion set in brass tops the staff, which is almost six feet in height and made of solid wood.
