



Housing at Pace Continuing Steps

Our Residential Communities

New York City – four residence halls:

- First-year
 - **182 Broadway** - mostly double and triple rooms (a few quads) with ensuite bathrooms
 - **Maria's Tower** – mostly double rooms with shared (but single-use) bathrooms
- Upper-Class
 - **33 Beekman** - mostly double rooms (a few triples) with ensuite bathrooms
 - **15 Beekman** – mostly larger suites (7 to 10 people) with multiple bedrooms (doubles and triples) and ensuite bathrooms

What's in a Room?

While there are variations in size, shape and layout of resident hall rooms, the standard complement of furnishings includes one of each of the following per student:

- Bed with mattress
- Desk
- Chest of drawers
- Wardrobe or closet

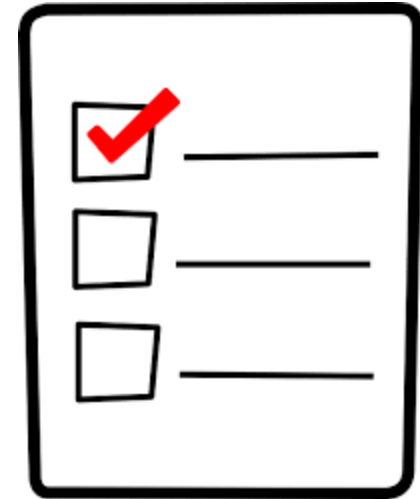
Residents will need to provide their own shower curtains and toilet paper (except in buildings with community bathrooms)

In college and in residential life, students will experience challenges within a supportive, communal environment. Some important expectations we have of our residents are that they will:

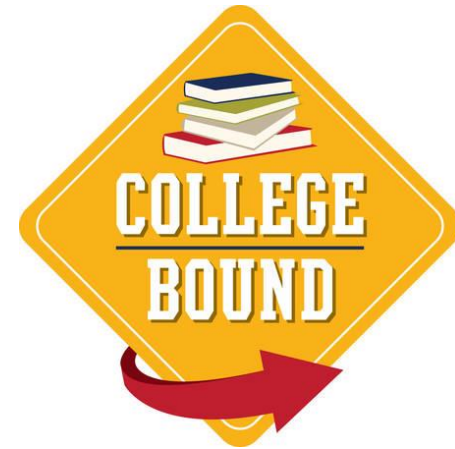
- **actively seek to get along** with members of the University community

 - accepting that Pace cannot accommodate all room change requests on demand

These expectations of living in a community setting are important to note, as they form the basis of developing a number of critical life skills. These experiences foster the development of a range of personal and interpersonal skills and qualities that will serve students well throughout their lives, including:

Move In!



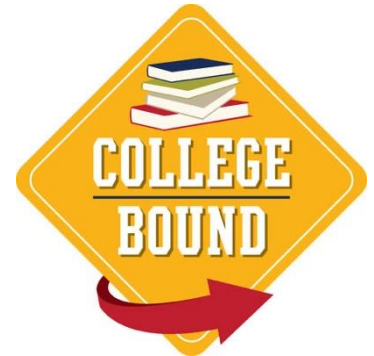
So, when exactly is Residence Hall move-in?

- NYC: new incoming students will primarily arrive on August 28 and 29
- **Students will be required to select a move in time prior to their arrival**
- Exceptions:
 - Some students will need to arrive earlier. These may include (among others):
 - Honors students
 - Pace Academy
 - Athletes
 - Students attending the last orientation program
 - Anyone arriving early will receive directions regarding how to register for a move in time and how/where/when to move in. Early arriving students may be asked to select an early move in appointment, or one may be issued to them by the Housing Operations team.
