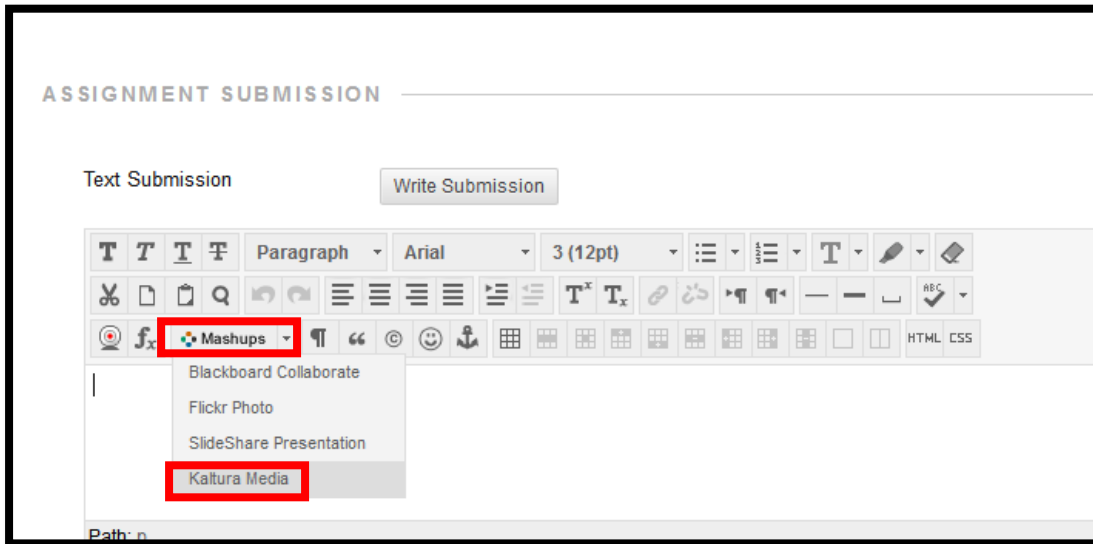

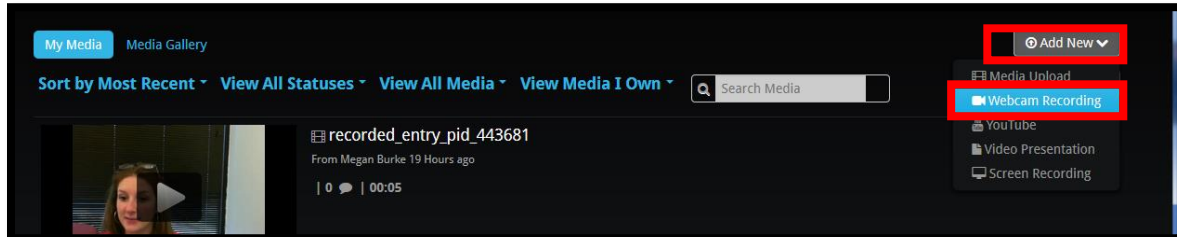

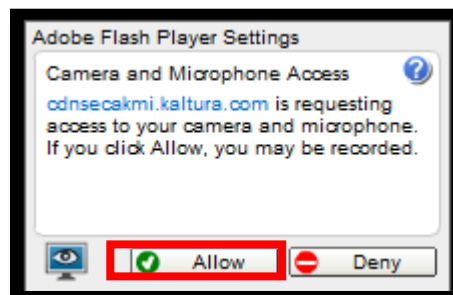
3. Click **Mashups** and choose **Kaltura Media**.

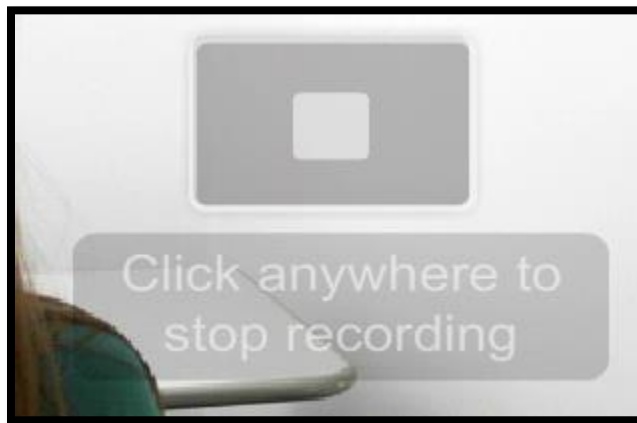

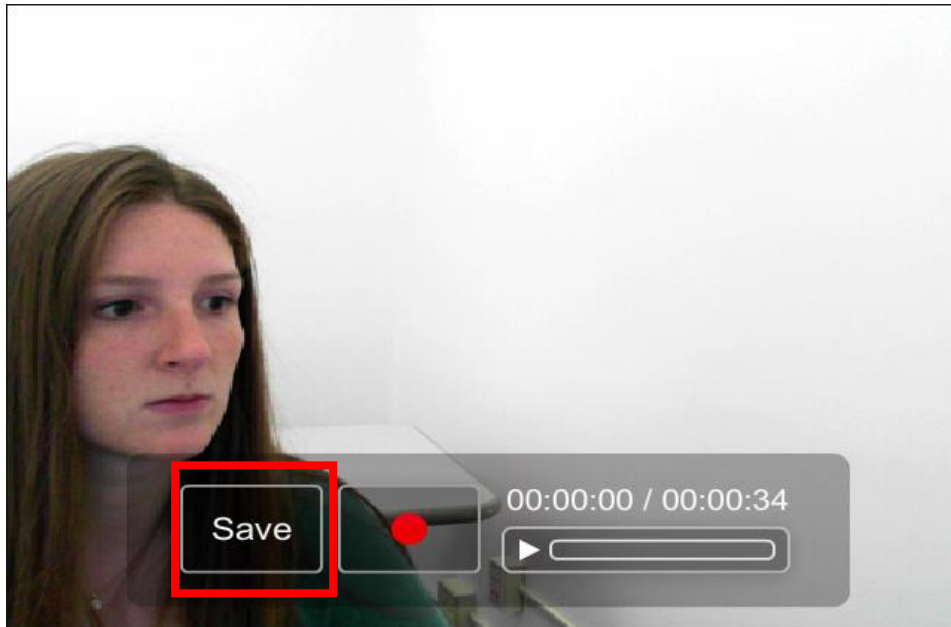


