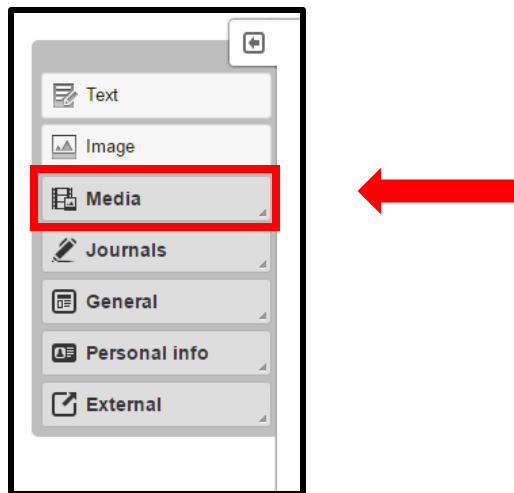


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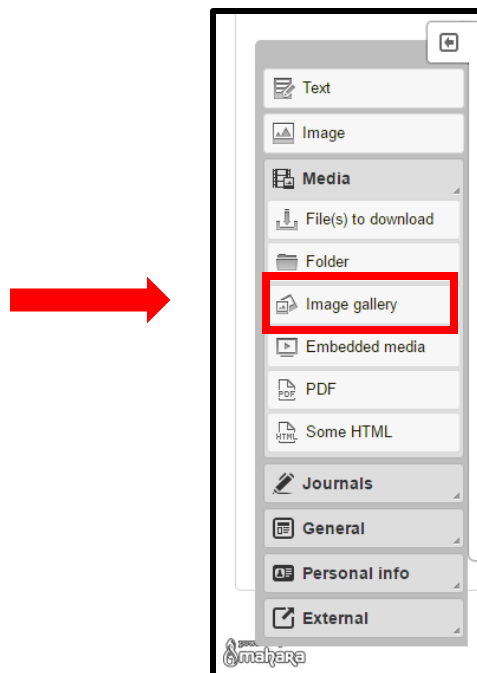
CREATING AN IMAGE SLIDESHOW

This tutorial shows how to add an image slideshow to your ePortfolio.

1. Select **Media** from the options menu.



2. Drag and drop the **Image gallery** block onto your page.



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3. A configure menu will open. From here, you can **title your slideshow**, or, if you want to leave it unlabeled, press the space bar in the **Block title** box.

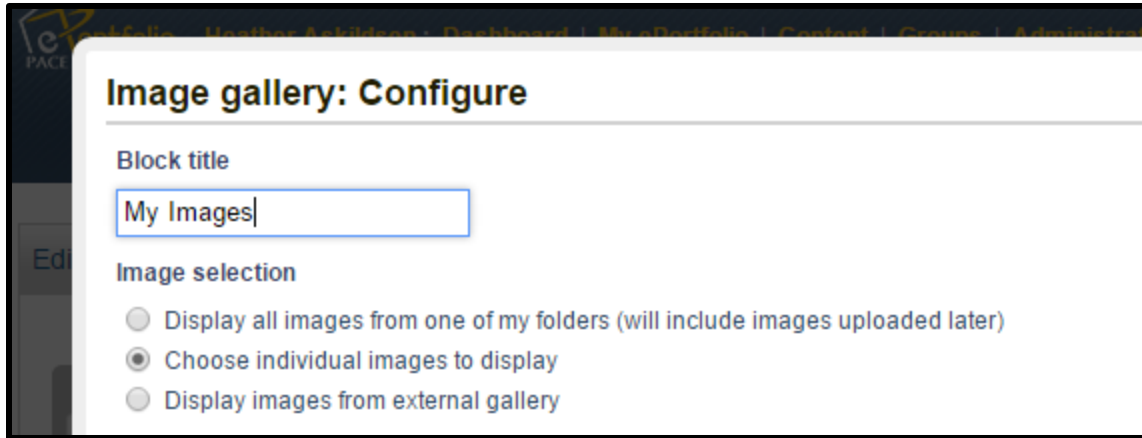

4. Under Image selection, select **Choose individual images to display**.

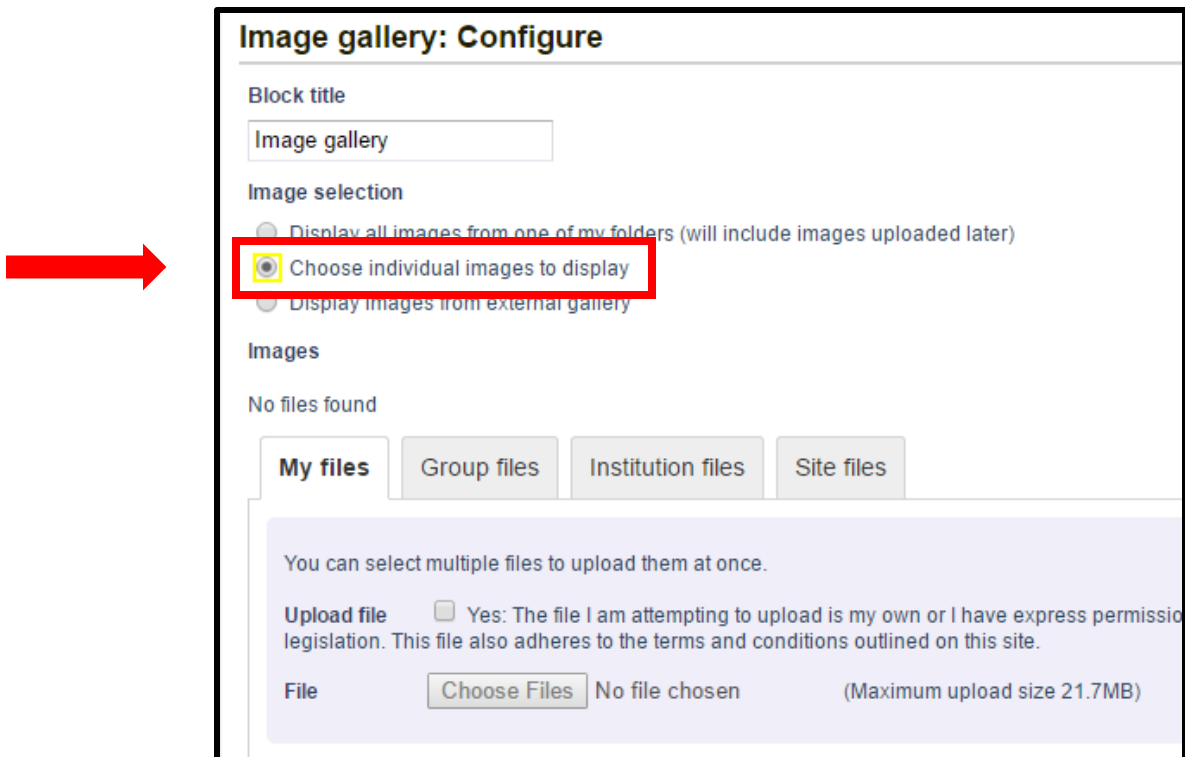

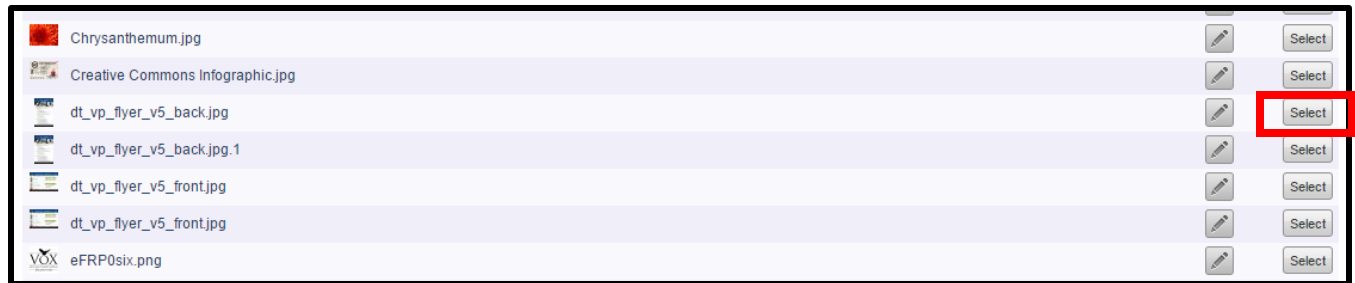

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5. Scroll down and hit **Select** next to the images you want to include in your slideshow



6. Under **Style**, select **Slideshow** and hit **Save**.
