

2019 Application for Summer Financial Aid Pace Law School

Priority Deadline April 26th, 2019

You MUST REGISTER for Summer courses BEFORE you submit this form, (except Work-Study only applicants).

A minimum of **6 credits** is required to be eligible for a federal student loan, which is the primary source of Summer funding. You must meet Academic Progress requirements to receive Federal aid. Academic Progress runs 6 weeks after Spring grades are submitted. If you no longer meet requirements, you will lose aid eligibility for summer.

If you are considering applying for <u>private alternative loans ONLY</u>, you do not need to complete this application. Please note that the processing of these loans may take up to 30 days.

Students who complete their applications and register on or before **April 26th**, **2019** should have their aid available for the Summer payment date. Students who file after this date, who are not registered, or who submit incomplete applications, may not have their aid available for the payment deadline and will be subject to a late fee as imposed by the Office of Student Assistance/Students Accounts.

Your Fall 2019 loan eligibility may be effected by borrowing Summer loans. Your 1920 loan eligibility may also be effected by using Federal Work Study funds during the summer term.

Application Date: Submit this form to the Financial Aid Office no later than **April 26**th, **2019** in order to have aid available before the start of the summer term.

Eligibility Guidelines/ Terms and Conditions for Summer Financial Aid

- I. Summer Federal Work Study: (No minimum credit requirement for continuing students)
 Summer Work Study will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis pending available funds.

 Pace will award up to \$6000 in potential Federal Work Study earnings to Law Students who demonstrate financial need according to program guidelines. If you are eligible and have obtained employment, you must submit all applicable forms, at least one month in advance of anticipated date of employment. The timely submission of accurately completed time sheets is required to receive paychecks by the payroll dates. Summer Work Study will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Your eligibility for Summer Federal Work Study will be determined upon receipt of this completed application.
 - If awarded on campus work-study funds you are responsible for obtaining a position. Eligibility does not guarantee a position.
 - Off-campus positions may be funded via Work Study. You must apply with the Public Interest Law Center.
 - Internships can either be for credit or paid via Work Study, not both.
 - It is possible that your summer earnings could impact your 2019/2020 academic year financial aid.

II. Summer Federal Loans: (Minimum of 6 Credits for Consideration)

You MUST file the 2018-2019 and the 2019-2020 FAFSA forms to be eligible for Summer Federal Loans

To receive a student loan for the Summer 2019 term, you must enroll in at least 6 credits.

<u>Please note</u>: If you do not attend or withdraw from classes, your loan will be subject to cancellation. Your student loan borrowing for 2018-2019 (and any prior years) will be reviewed to determine your maximum eligibility for Summer Loan Funds. If you accept your federal Stafford loans and are a first time borrower, before your loans can be disbursed, you must sign a Master Promissory Note (MPN) and complete Loan Entrance Counseling on www.studentloans.gov.

III. Alternative Enrollment:

To apply for financial aid for alternative enrollment programs such as Study Abroad, you should speak with a financial aid counselor to discuss your options and complete the appropriate paperwork.

IV. Law School Scholarships and Grants:

Law School Trustee Tuition Grants and most Merit Scholarships are <u>not</u> available for the summer term. Contact the Financial Aid Office if you have questions.

IMPORTANT:

<u>If you change your Summer enrollment by withdrawing, dropping or switching credits, your aid is subject to reduction or cancellation.</u> Please be sure to file the 18-19 and 19-20 FAFSA forms.
