

**List of Capstone and Seminar Courses Suitable for the

Students must obtain academic credit in some form for their thesis work. In order to do so, students may take one of a number of approaches:

- Enroll in a Capstone course or Senior Seminar designed to produce a thesis
- If there is no appropriate course in your major, a student may receive credit for the thesis through an Independent Study course in that field (395). Students must receive permission from the Instructor and the Department Chair to create an Independent Study section.
- Enroll in HON 499 -- a one-credit course geared toward the Senior Thesis. The class focuses on research methods for all majors and disciplines.
